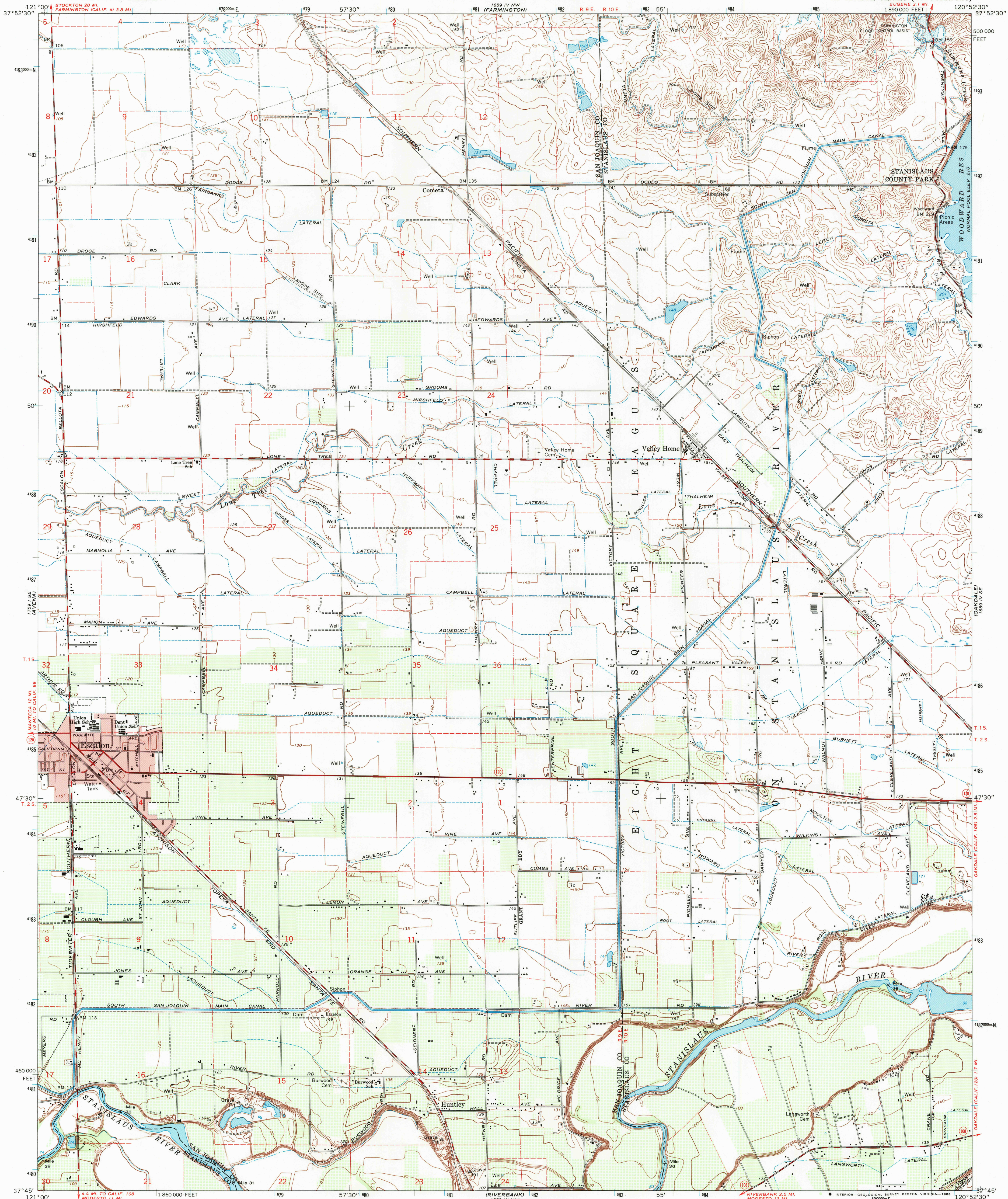




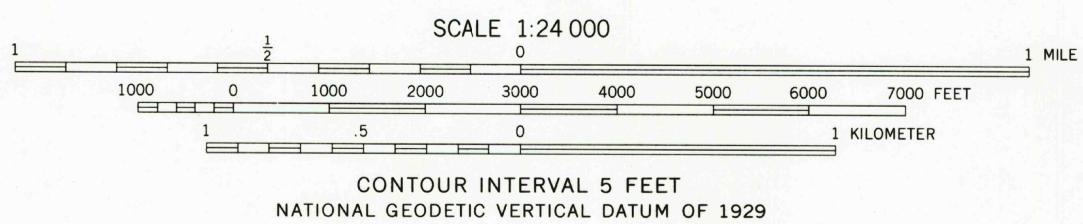
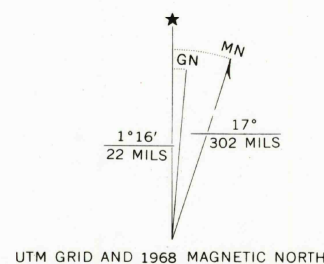

91 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern
are subject to controlled inundation
