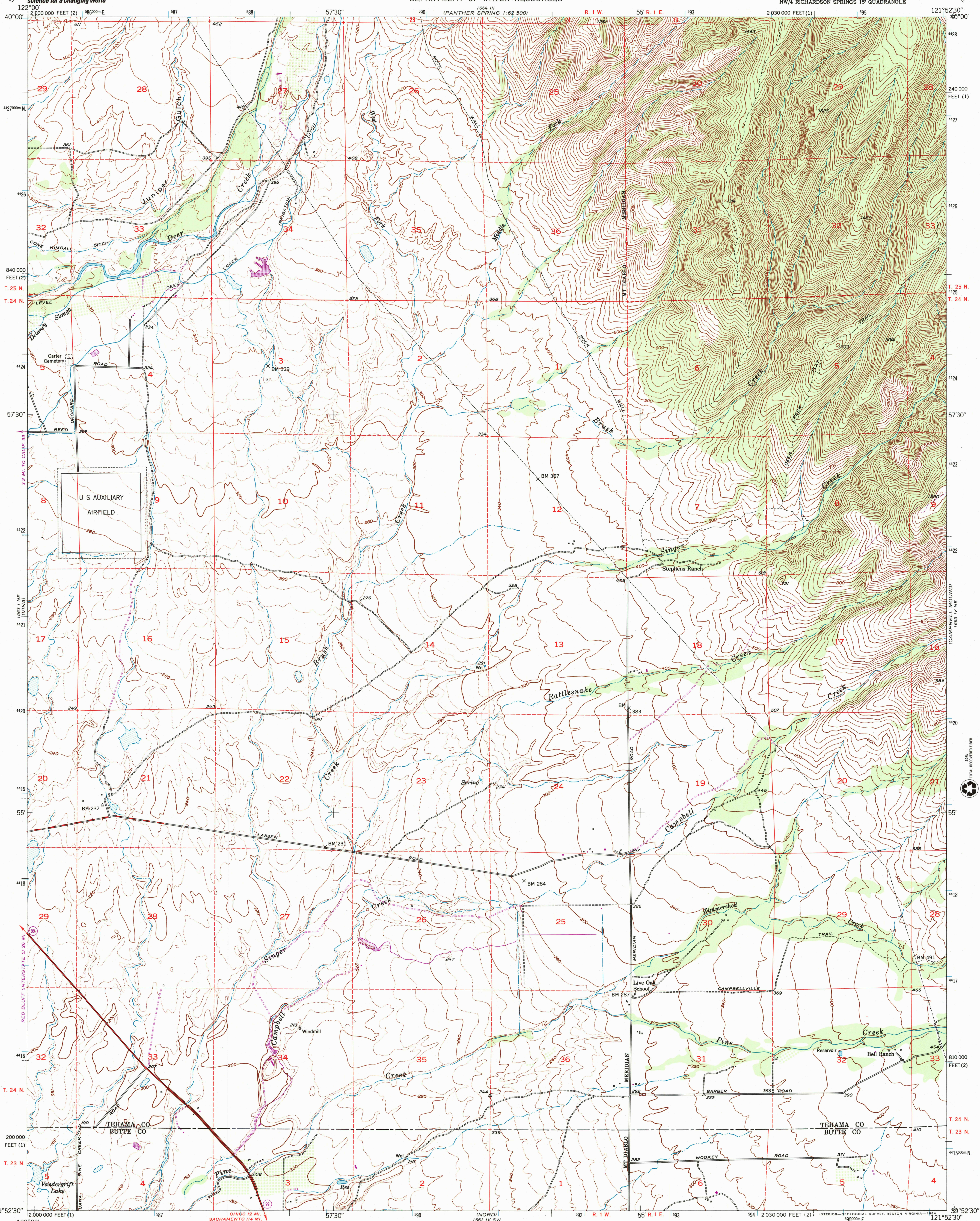

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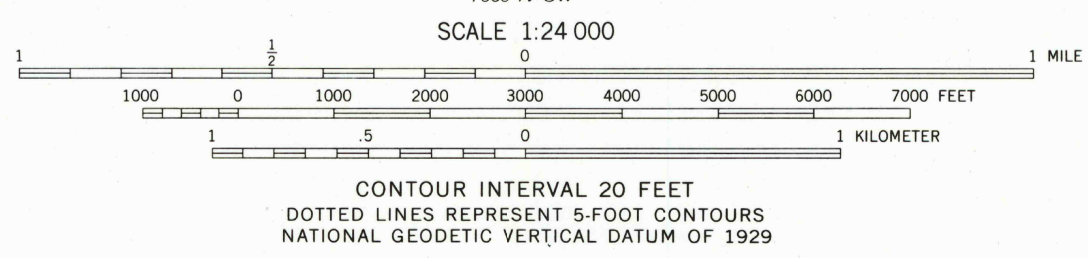
Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods and by plane-table surveys 1952. Aerial photographs taken 1947

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 17 meters north and 94 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
