

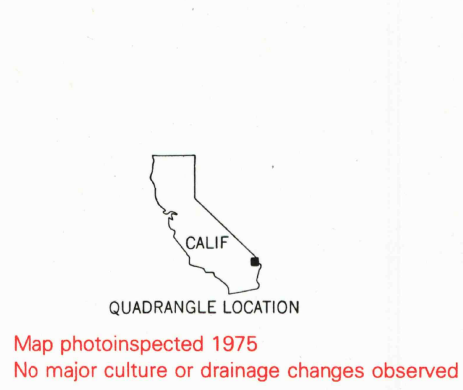
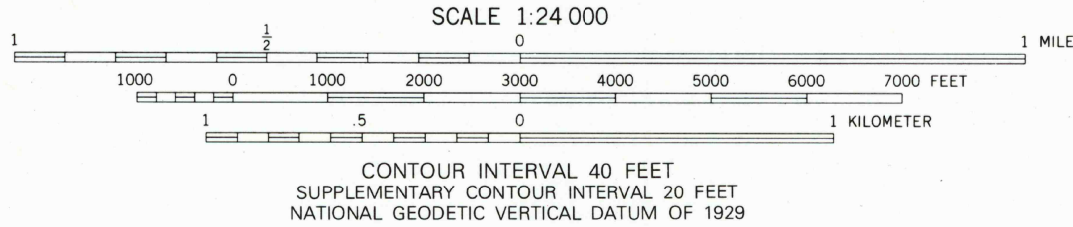
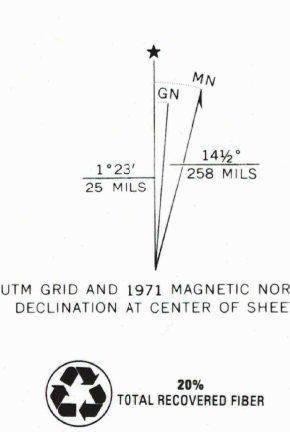

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 11, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection line 1 meter north and 73 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown to this map
