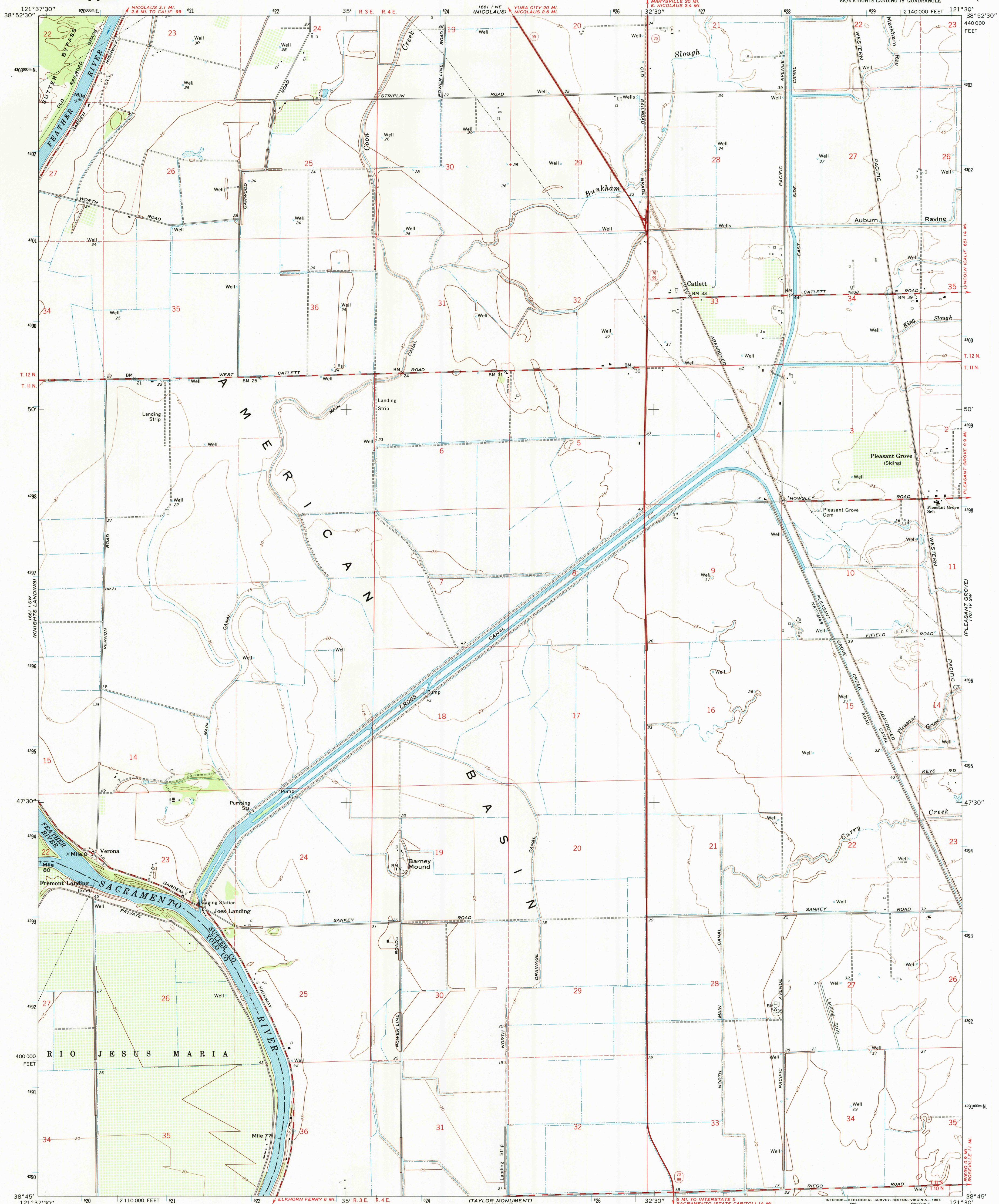


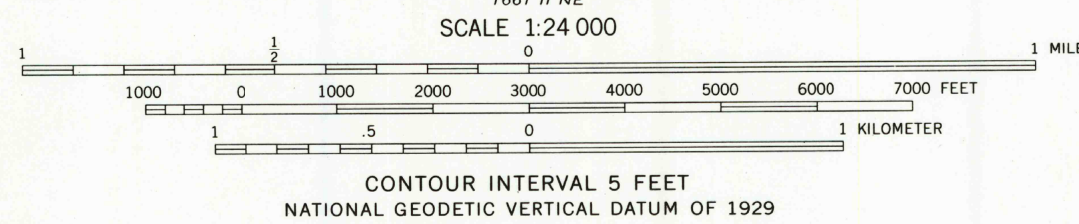
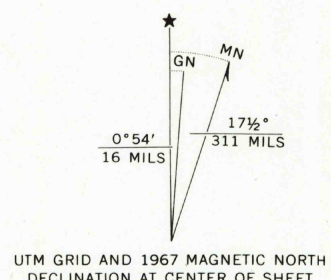

92 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Dotted land lines were established by private survey
Land grant boundary which follows the bank of the
Sacramento River is not shown
Sutter Bypass areas subject to inundation during periods of high water
