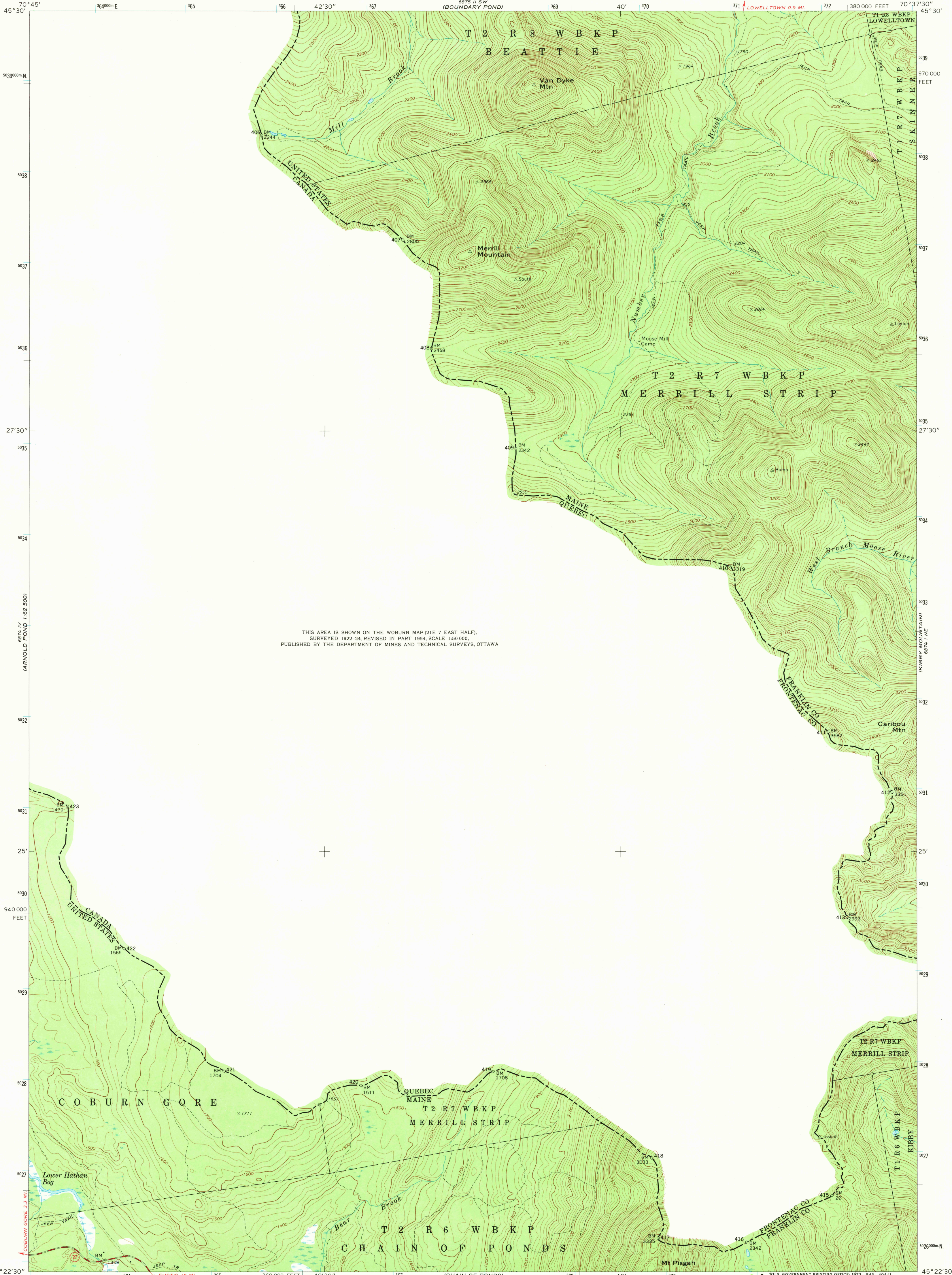


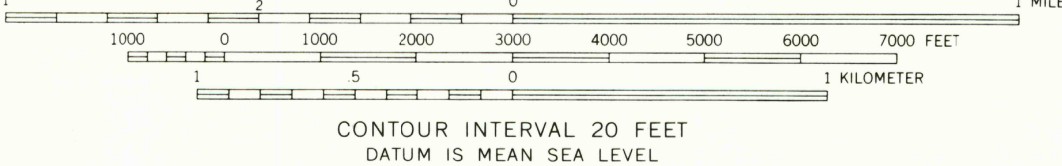
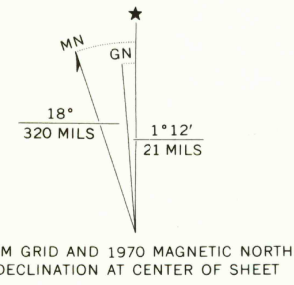

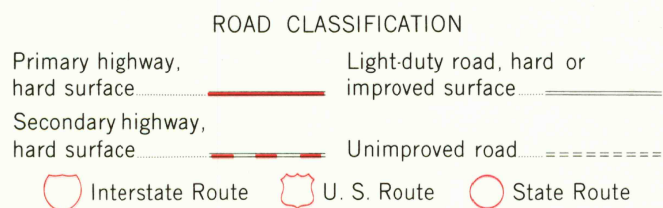


THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE WOBURN MAP (21E 7 EAST HALF),
