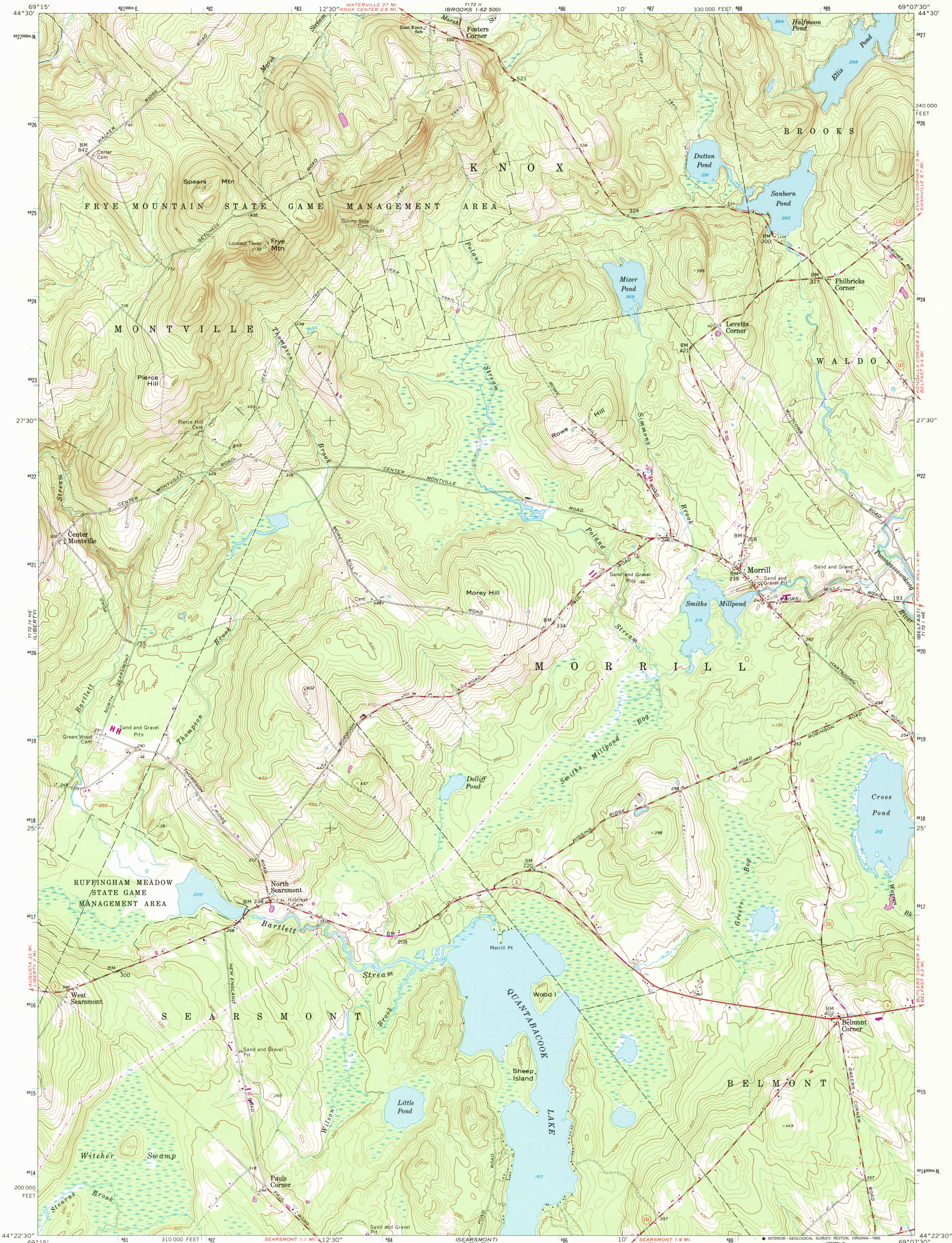

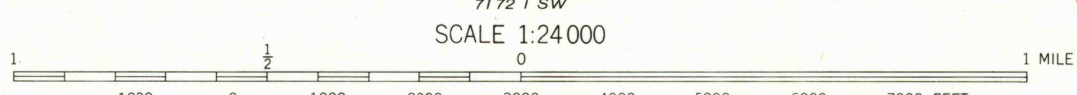

taken 1973. This information not field checked

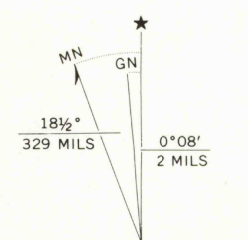
