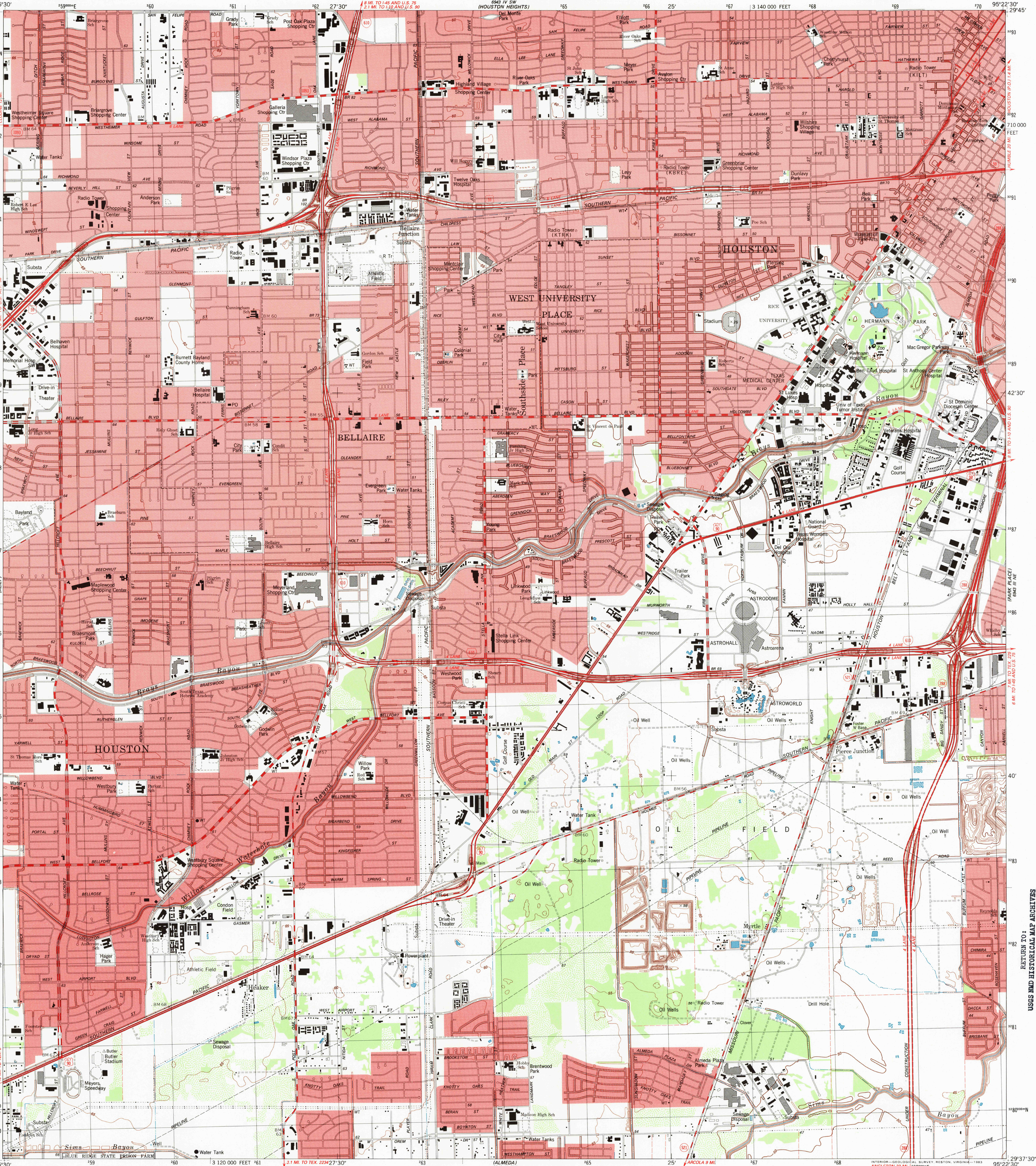


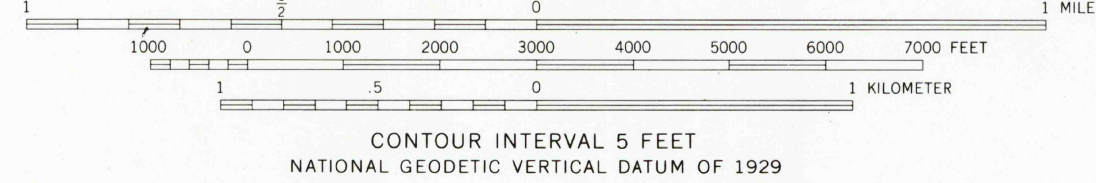
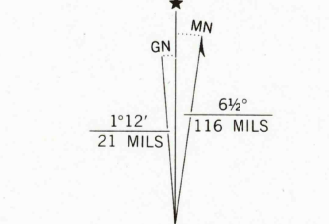

move the projection lines 20 meters south and
22 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
A portion of this map lies within a subsidence area
Contouring based on 1973 adjustment of vertical control
