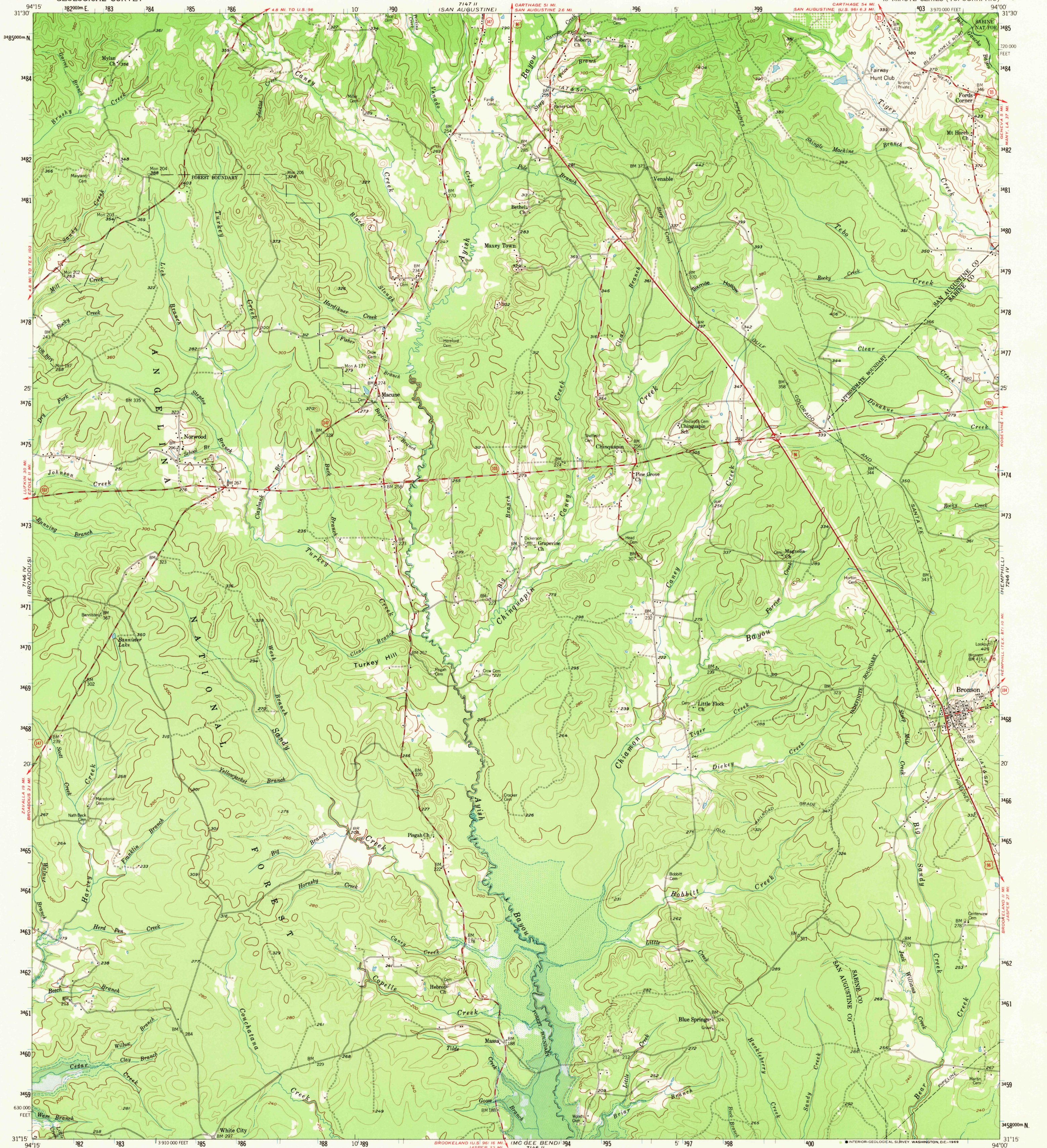

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue

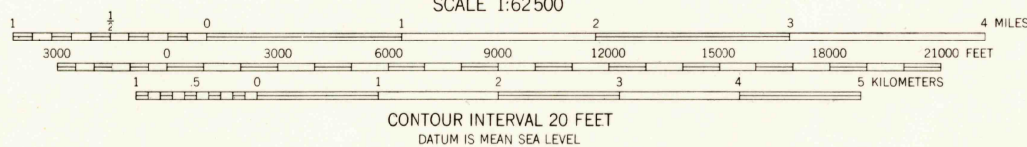
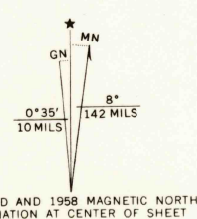
Blue hatching indicates areas to be flooded by proposed
