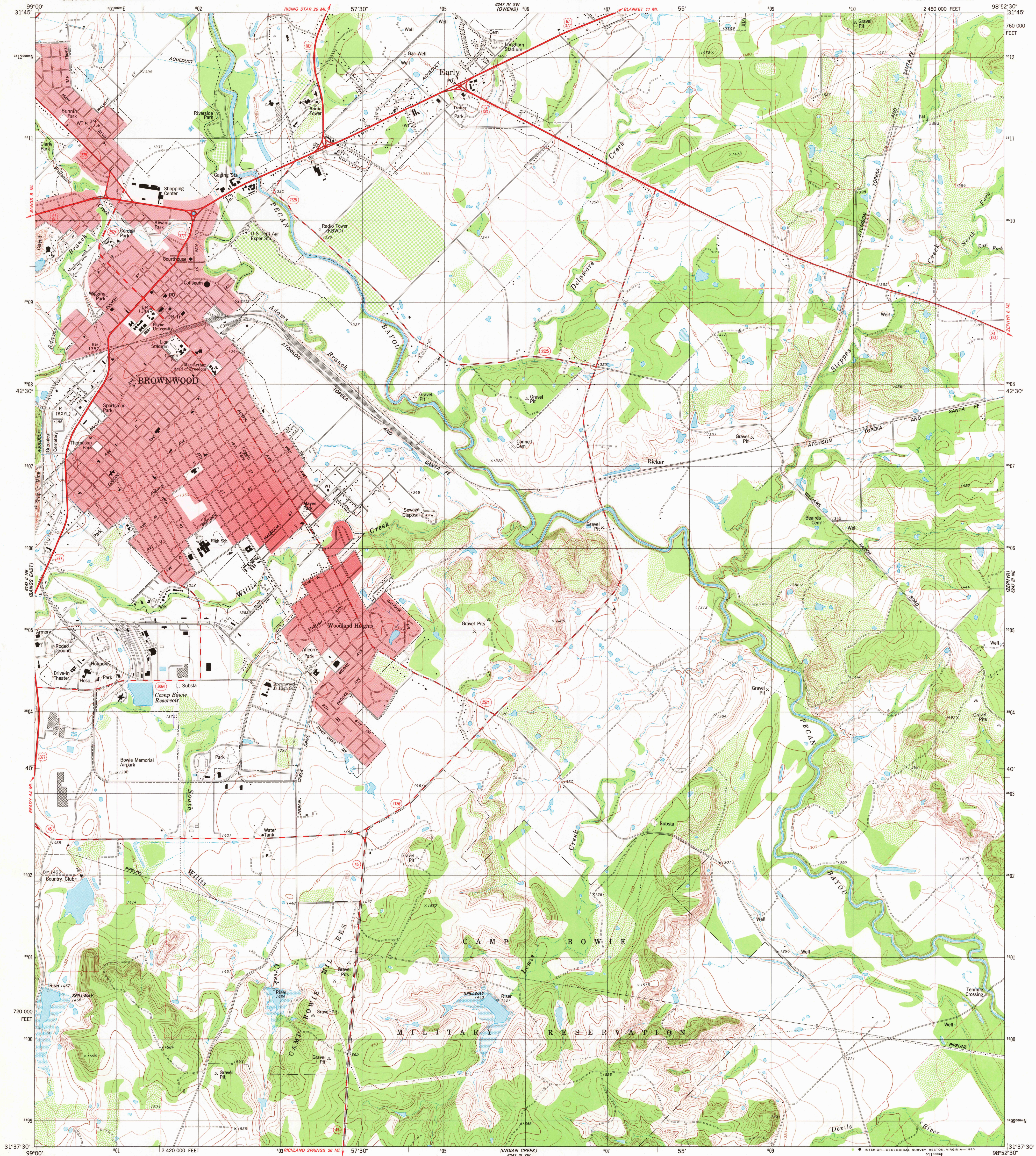

move the projection lines 13 meters south and

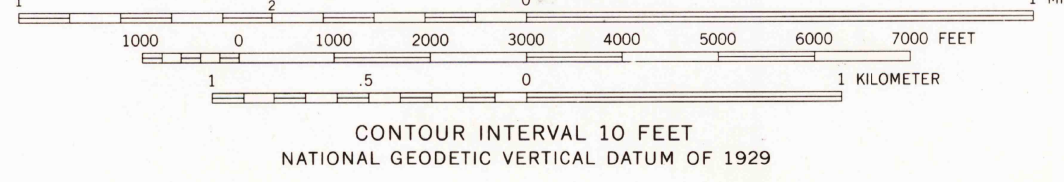
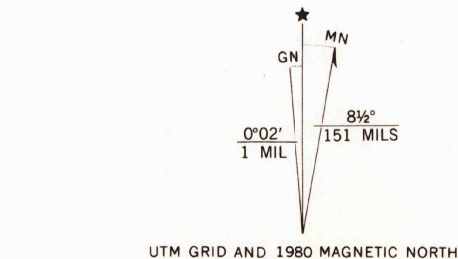
31 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
