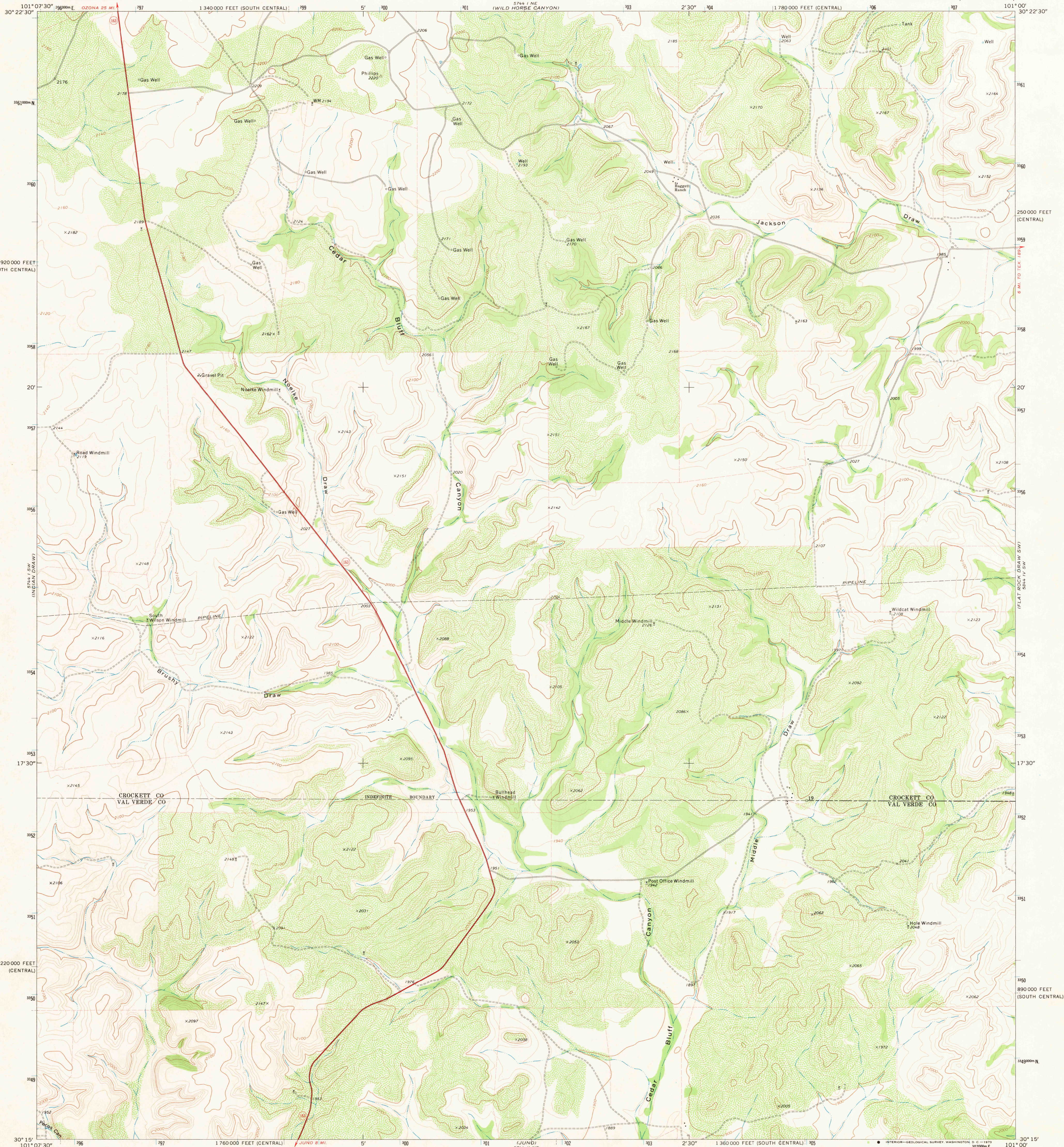

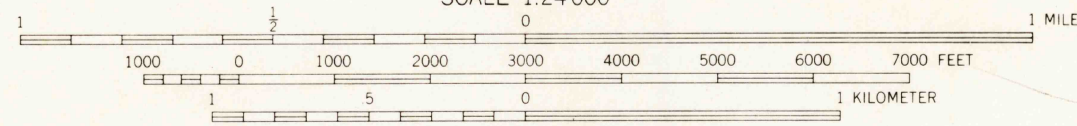
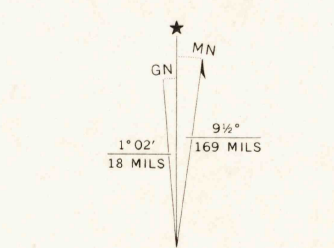
10,000-foot grids based on Texas coordinate system,
