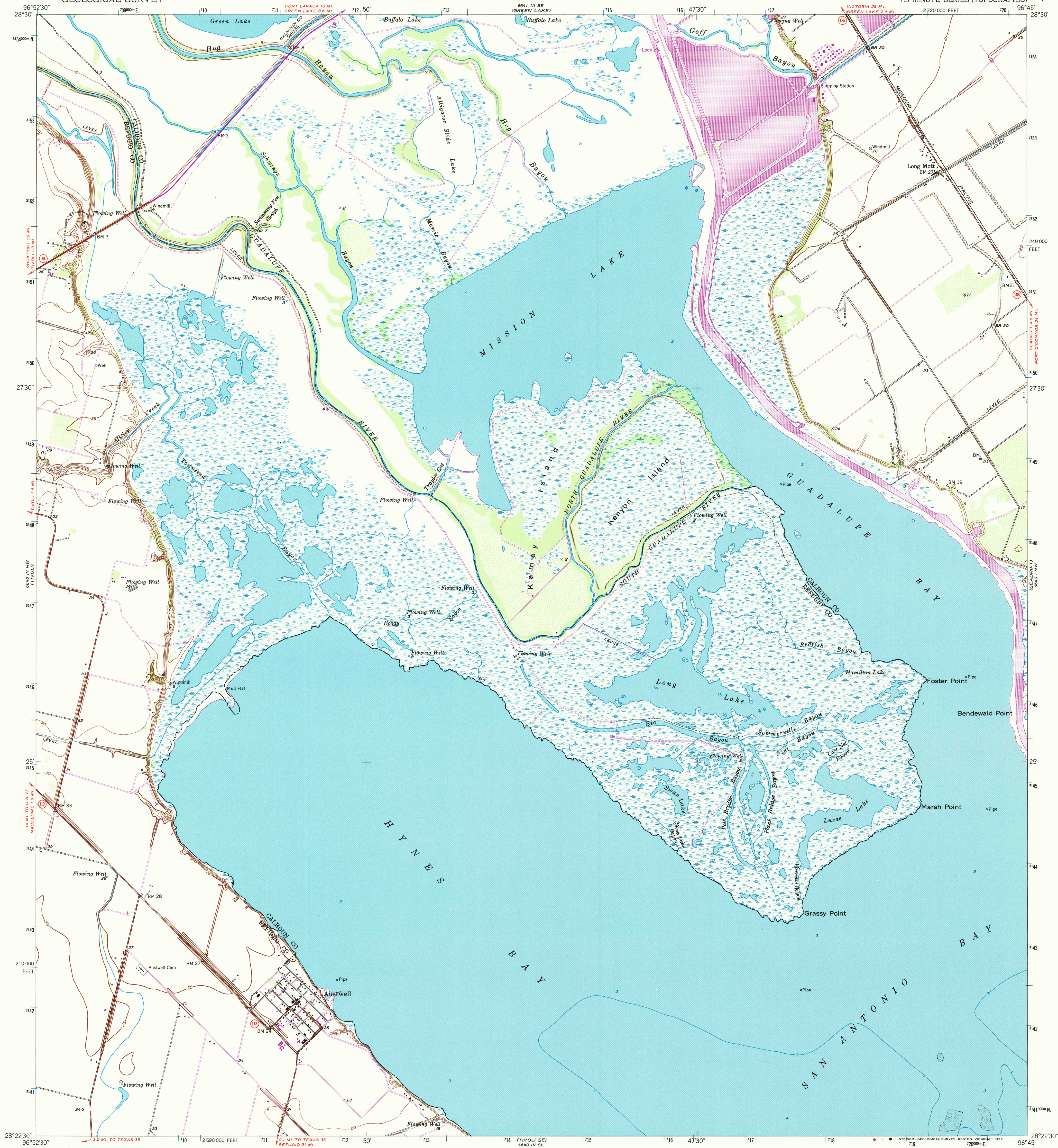

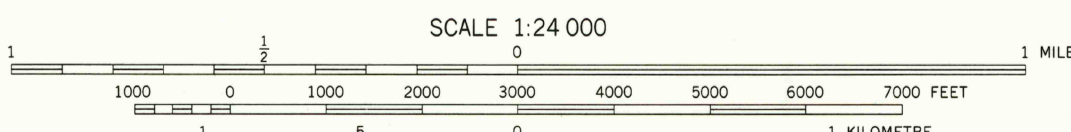
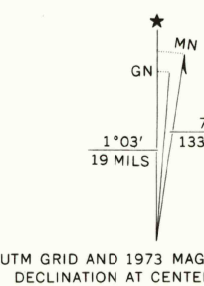

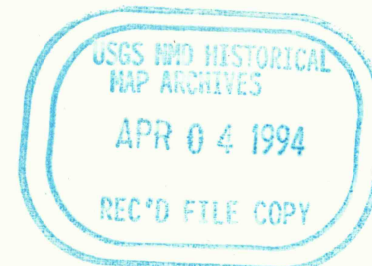
NATIONAL GEODETIC VERTICAL DATUM OF 1929
