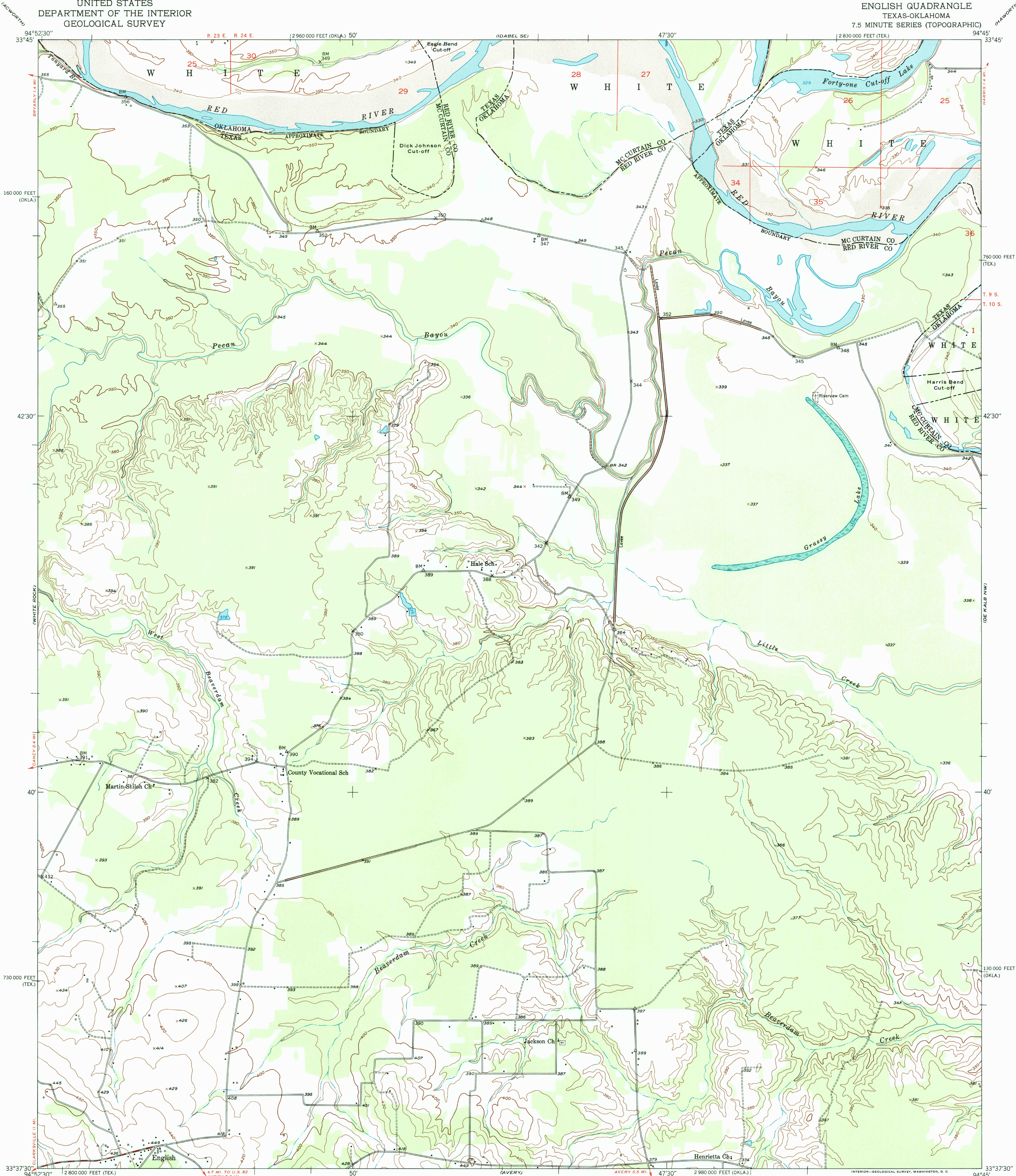


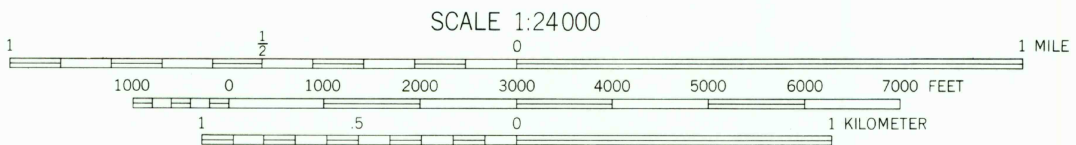

south zone

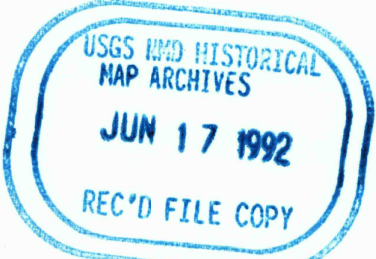
