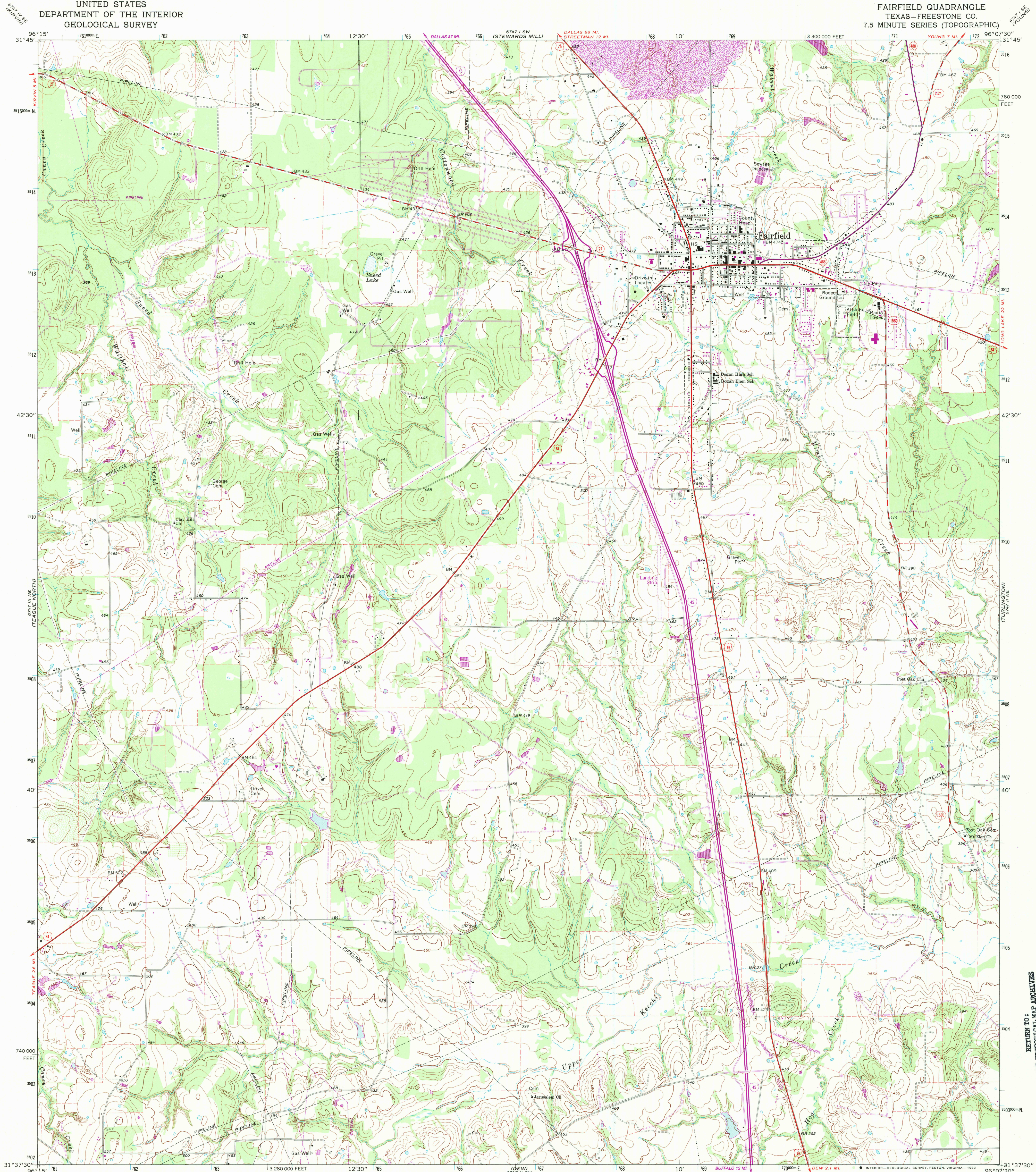




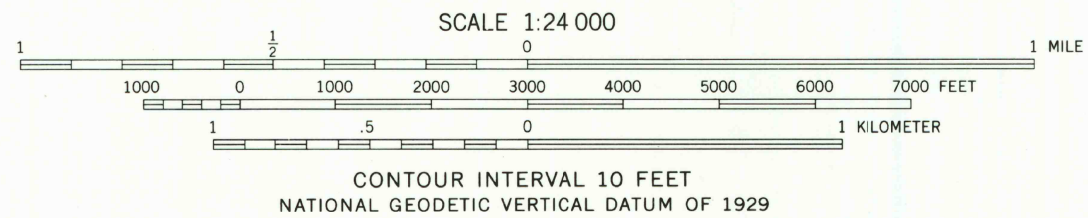
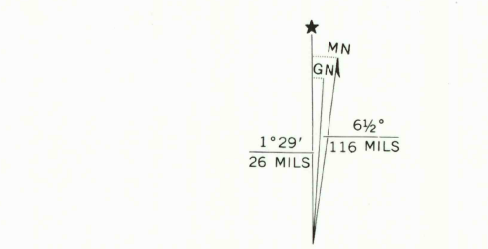

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

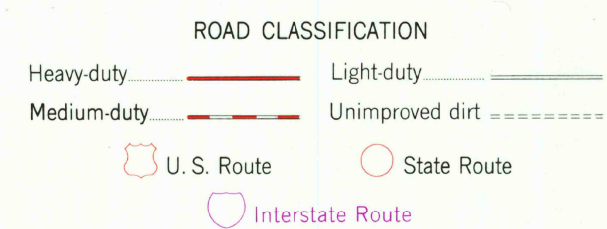
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
