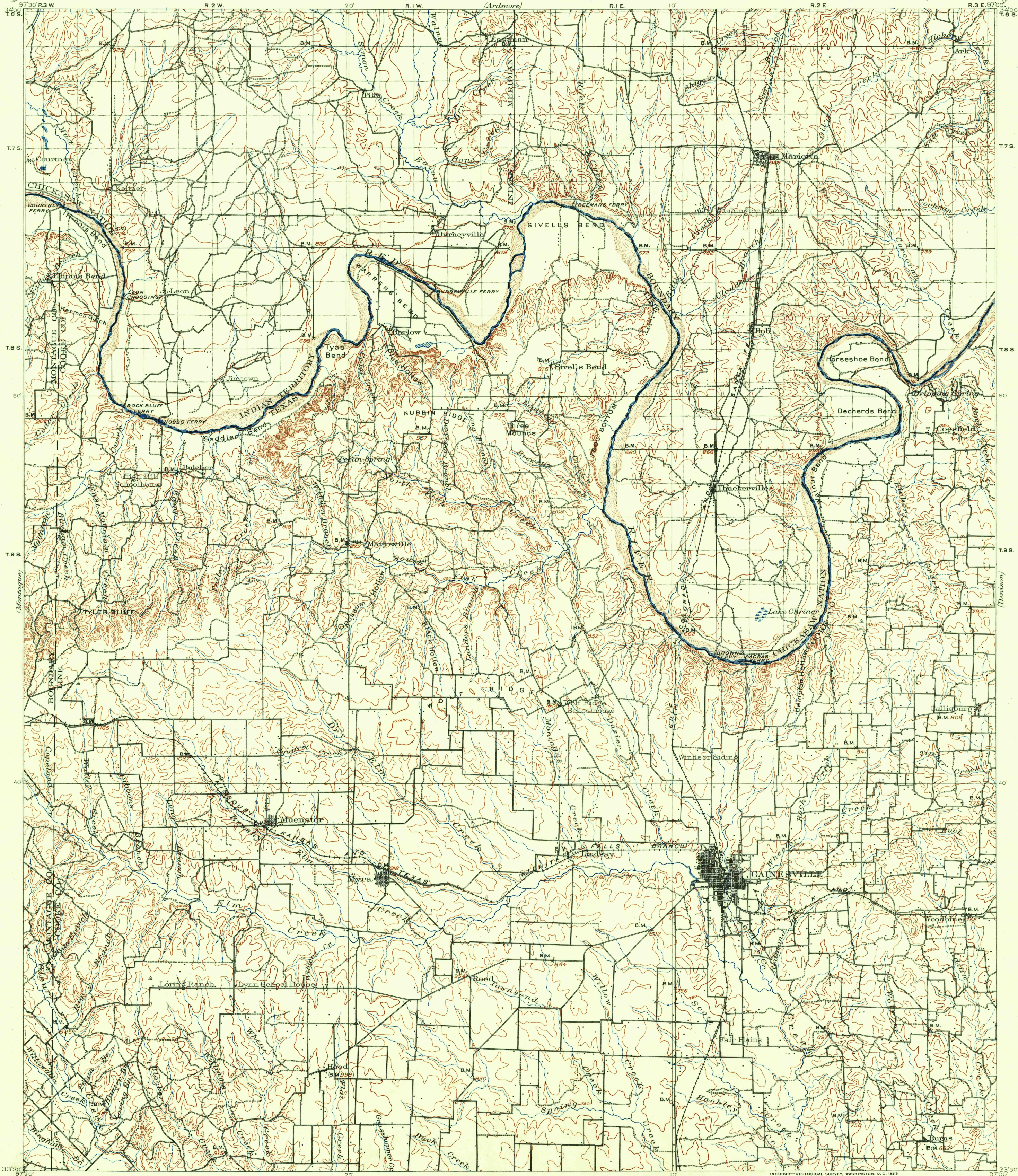

DECLINATION 1902

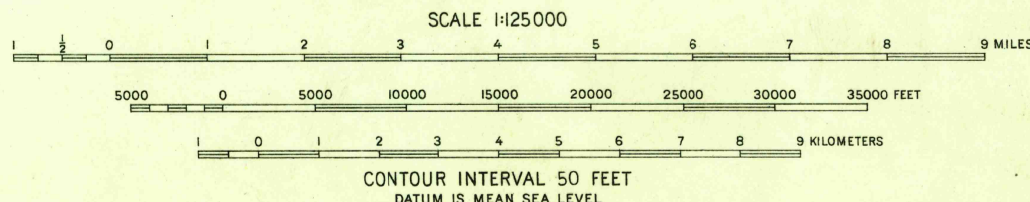


DIAGRAM OF TOWNSHIP
