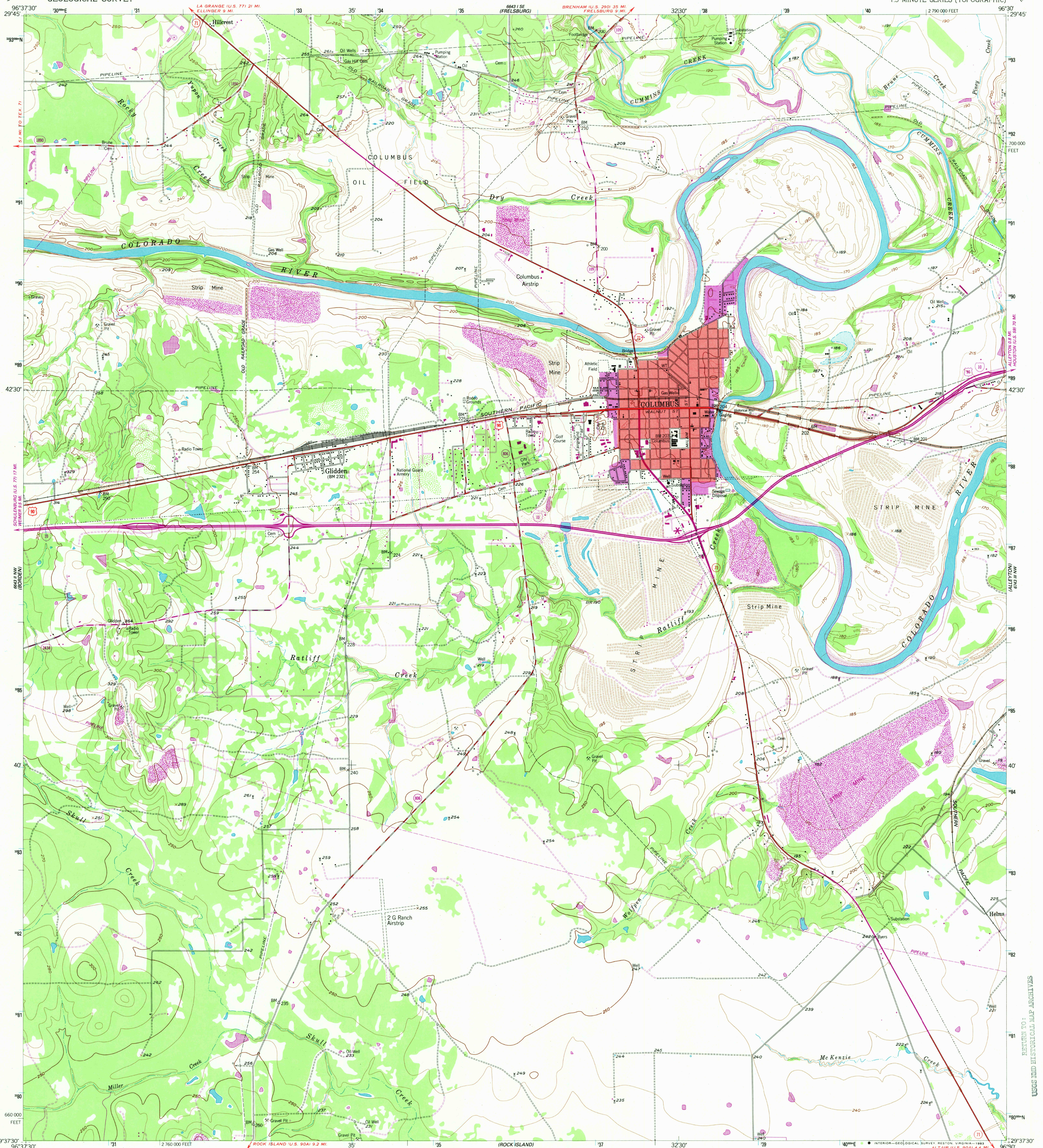

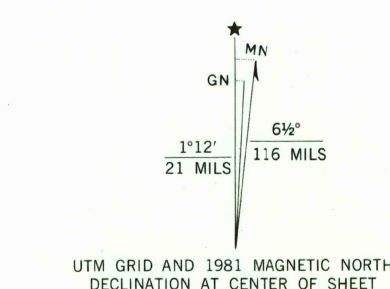

zone 14, shown in blue

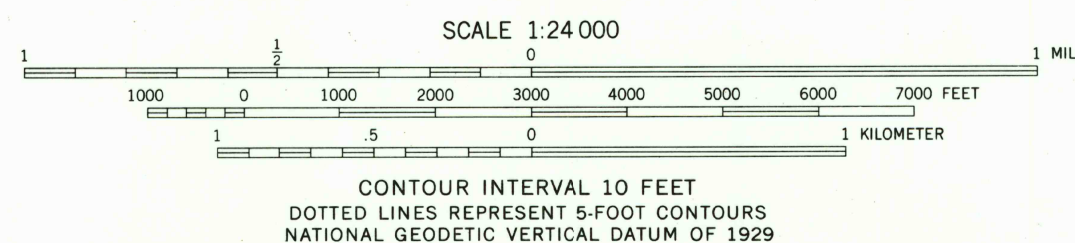
Red tint indicates area in which only

Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas



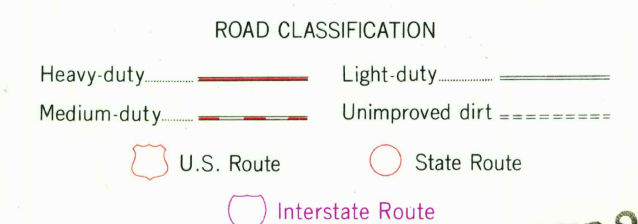
