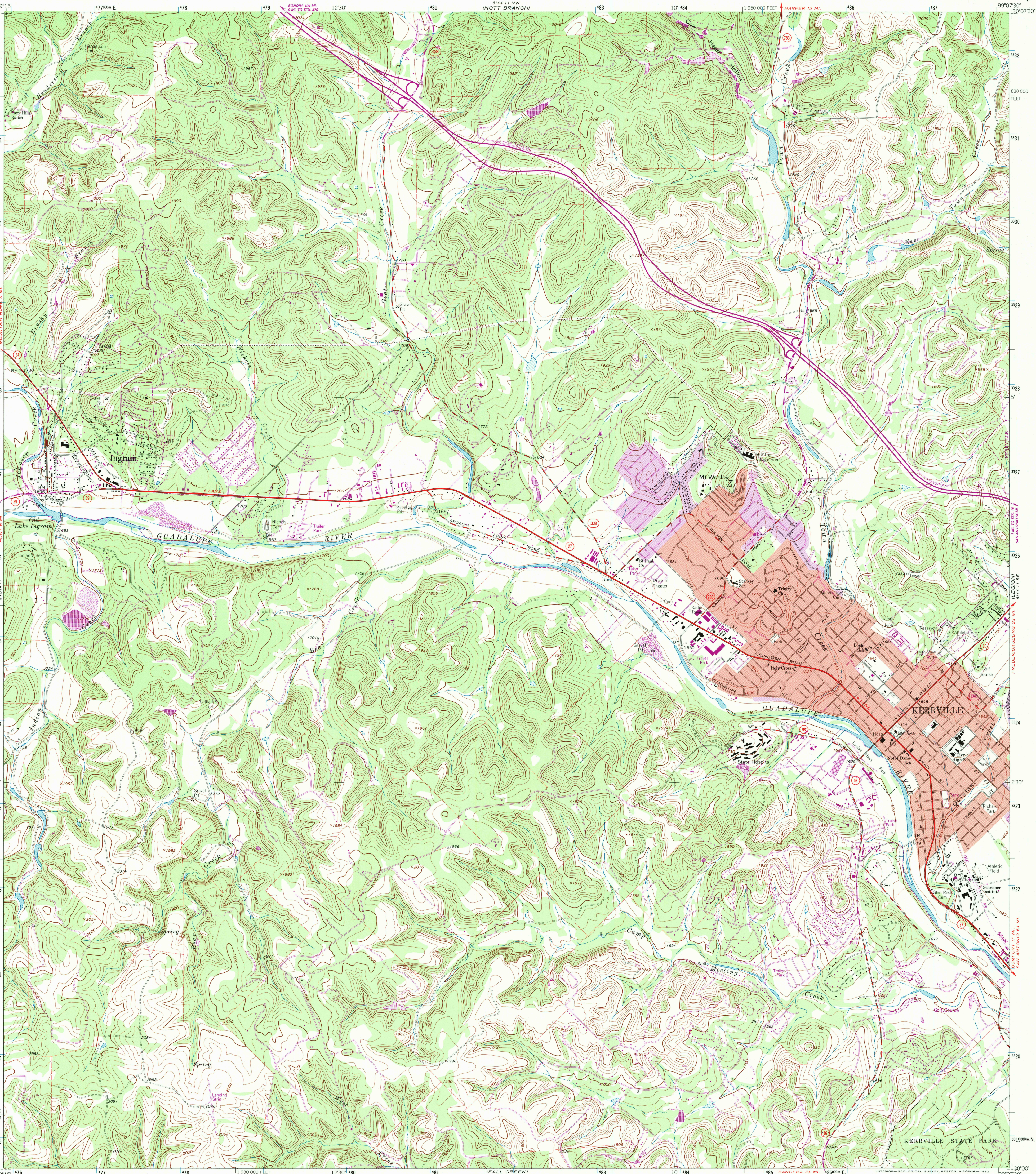

1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 18 meters south and 31 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

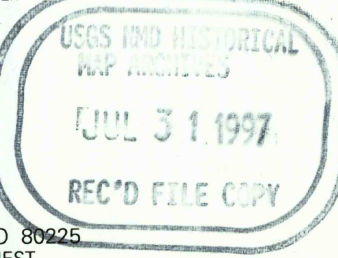
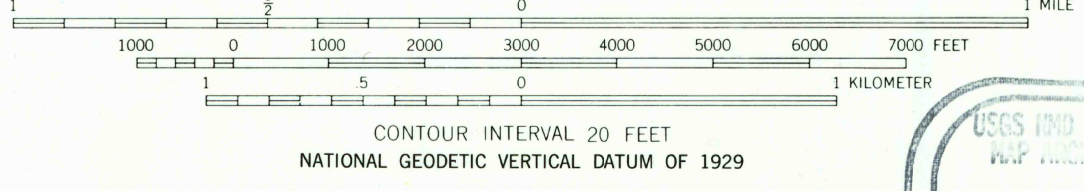
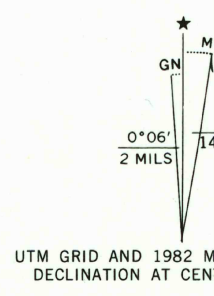
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
