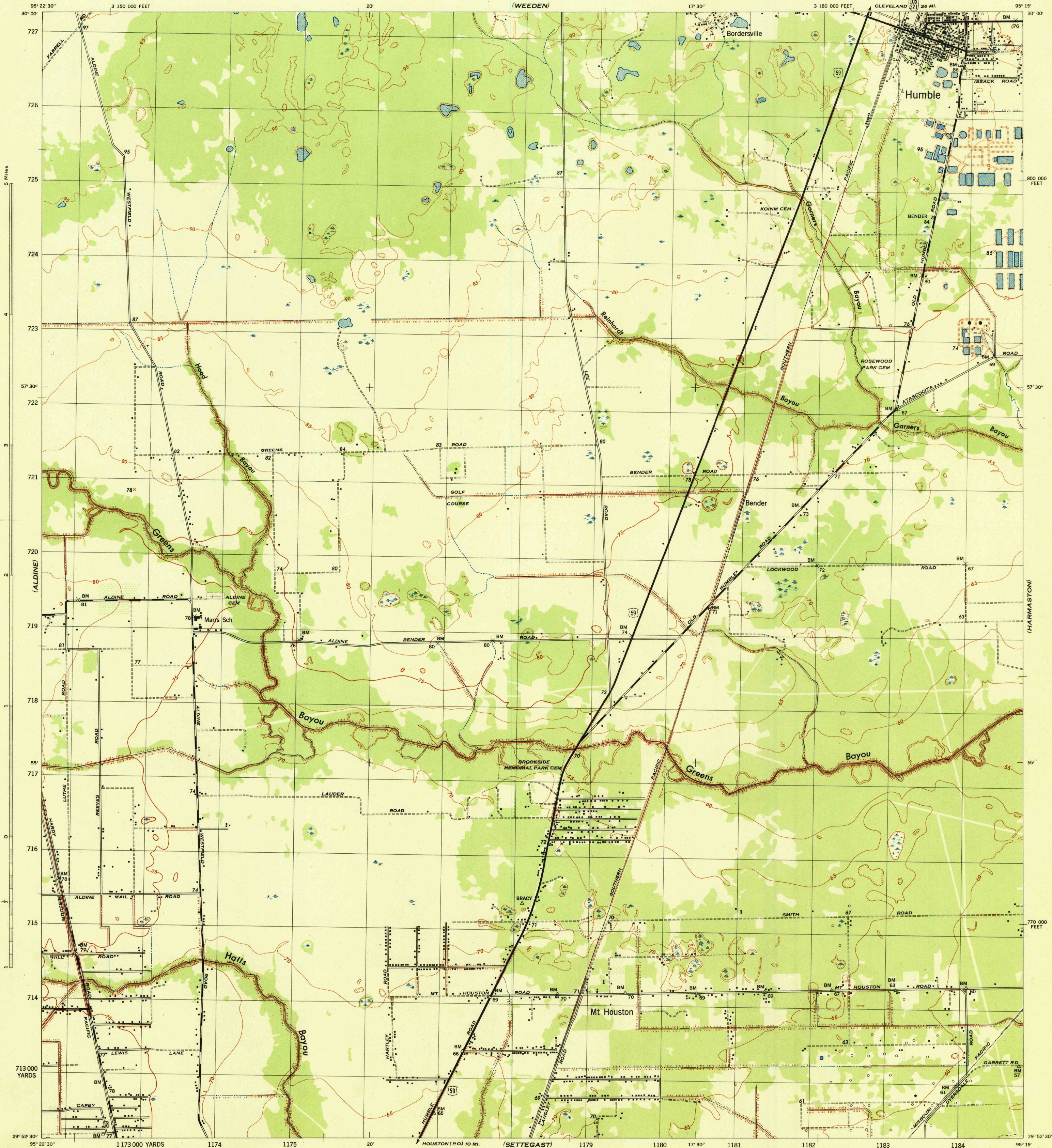

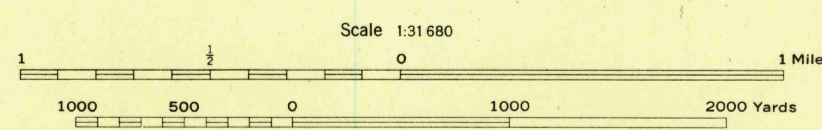
HUMBLE QUADRANGLE

More than two lanes indicated by note along road with tick at point of change. ——— 3 LANE 1 LANE

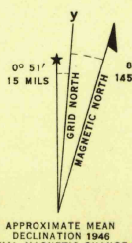
