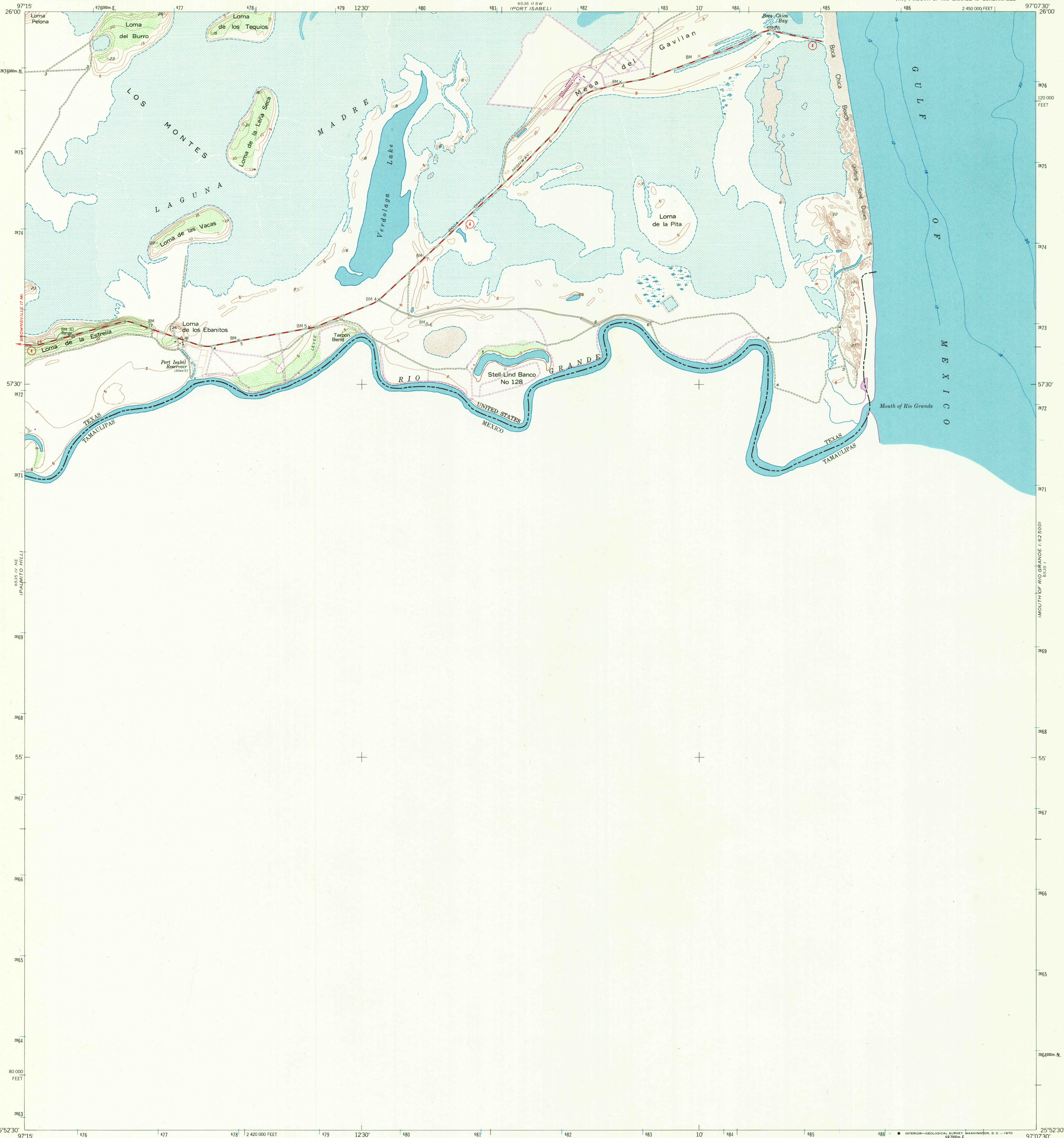

NW/4 MOUTH OF RIO GRANDE 15' QUADRANGLE

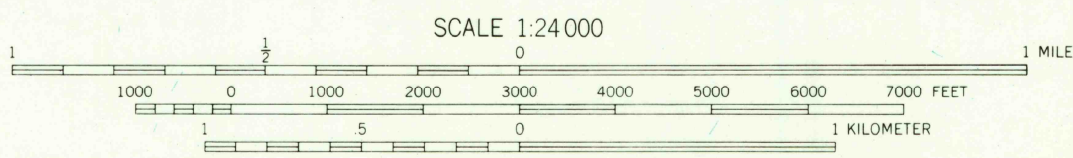
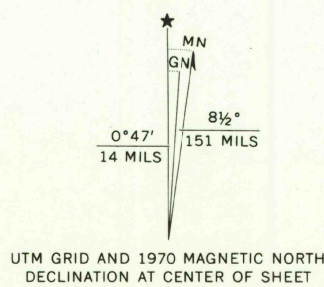
