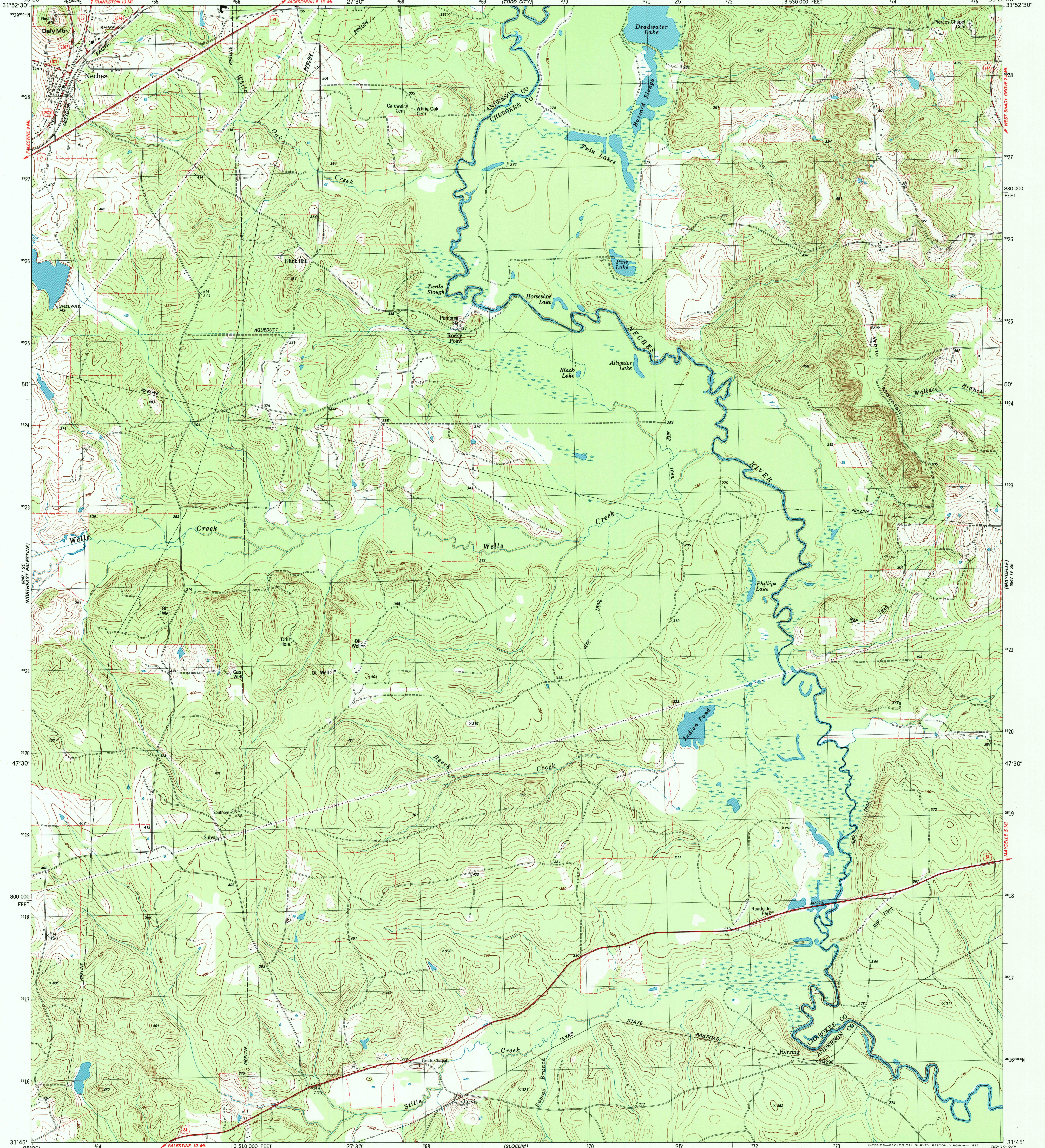

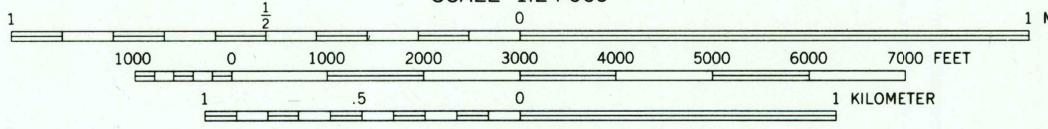

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 14 meters south and 22 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
