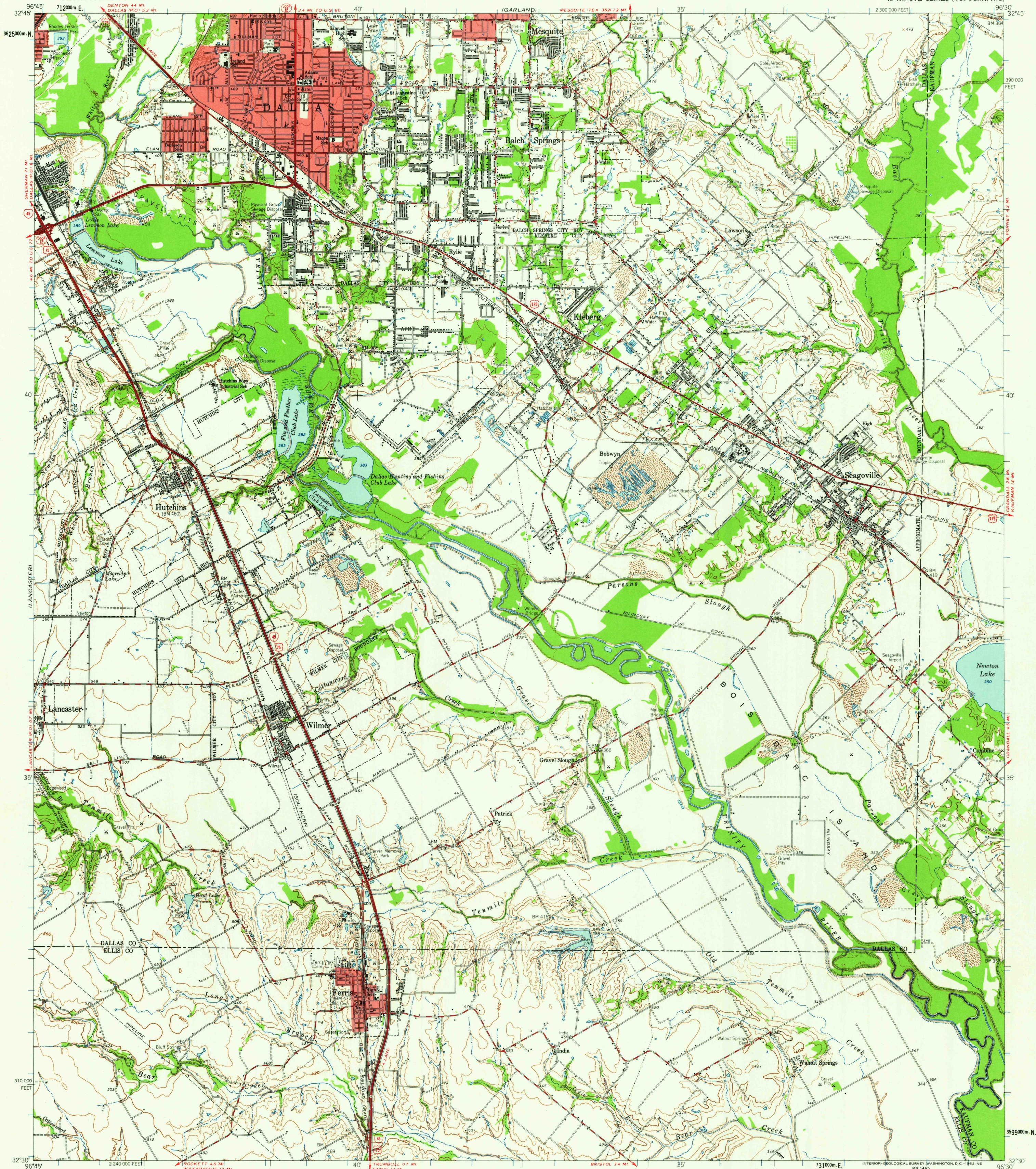

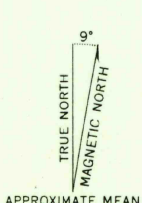

Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum, 10,000-foot grid based on Texas coordinate system, north central zone

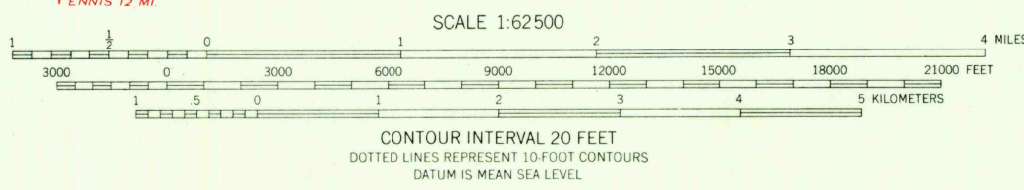
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 14, shown in blue
