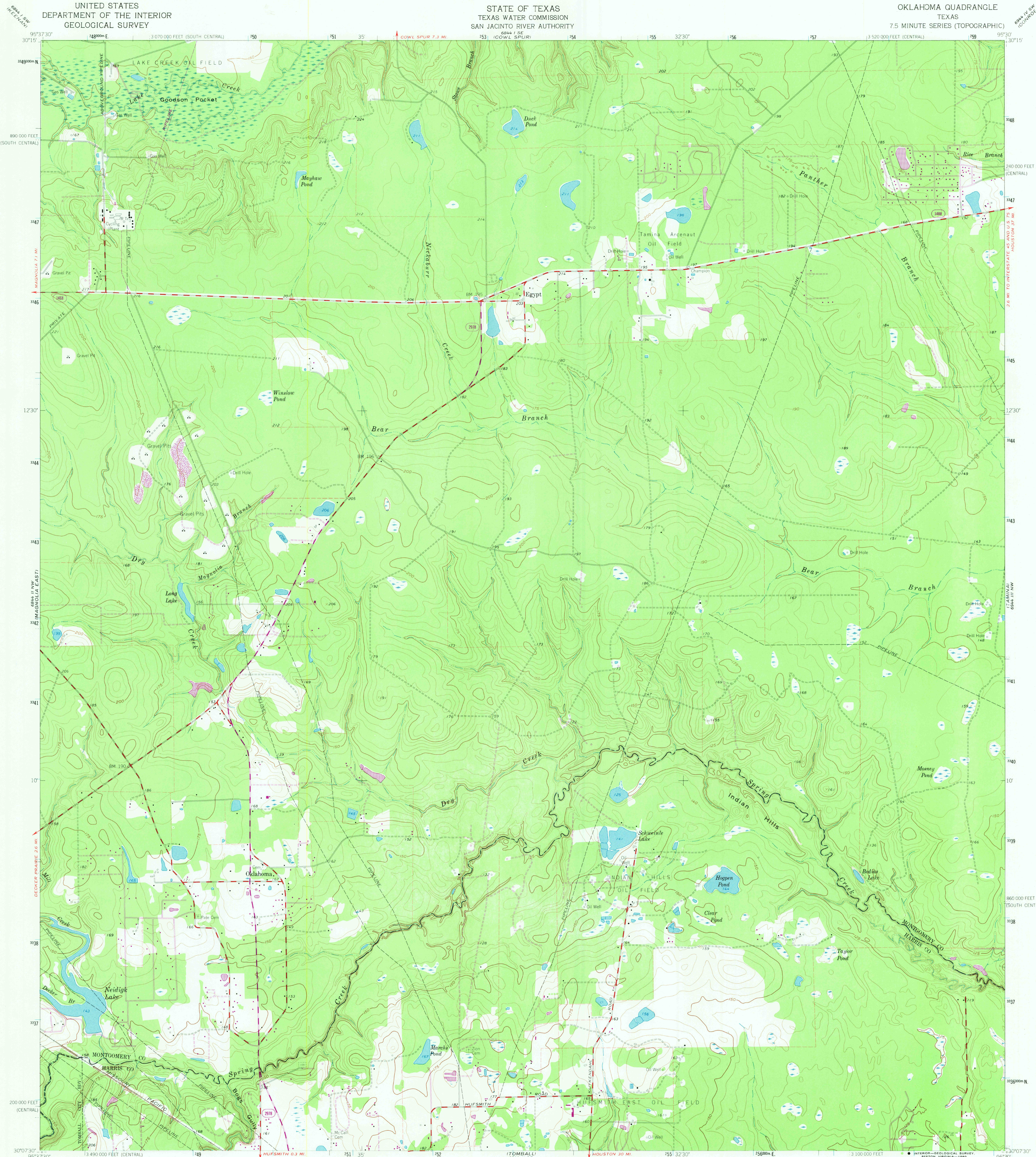




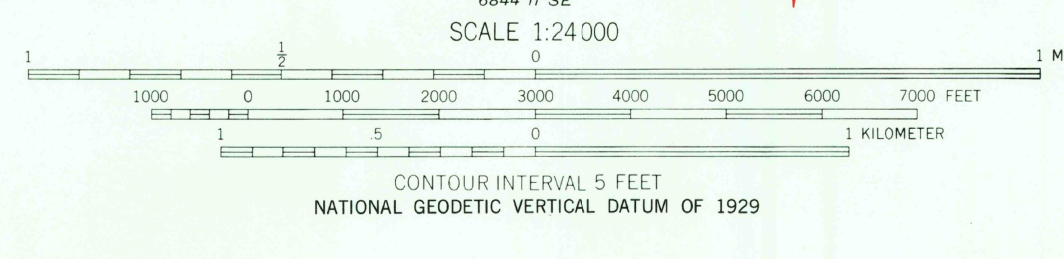
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Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs

central and south central zones.
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
zone 15, shown in blue.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,
move the projection lines 19 meter south and
22 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
