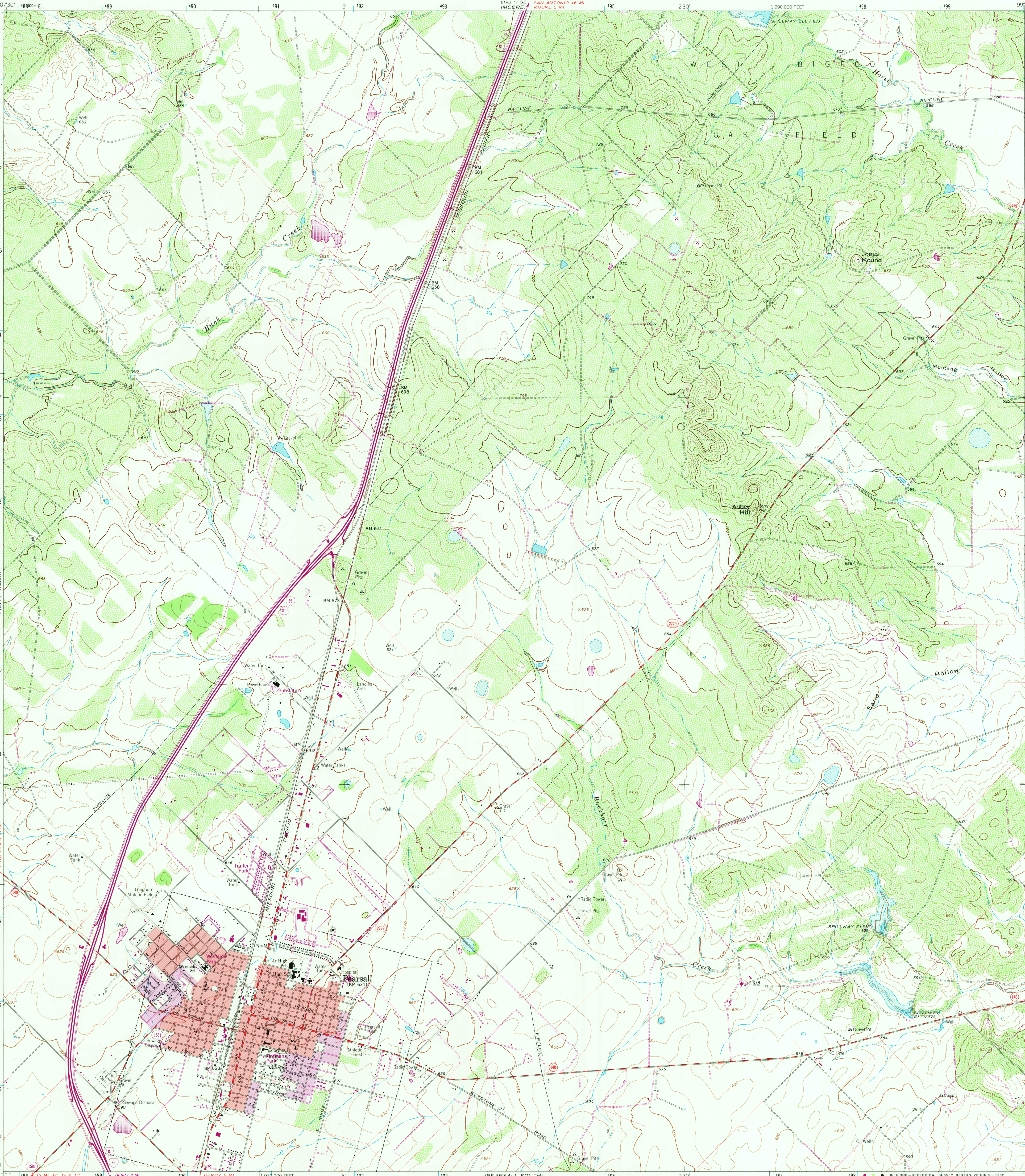

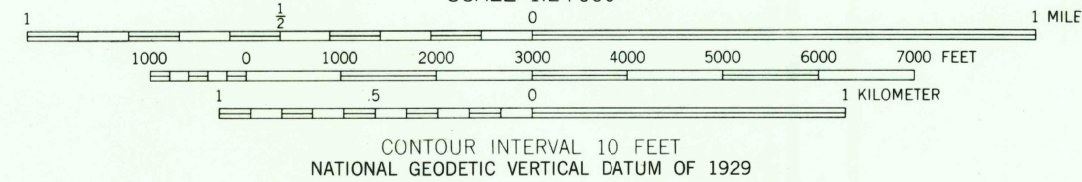
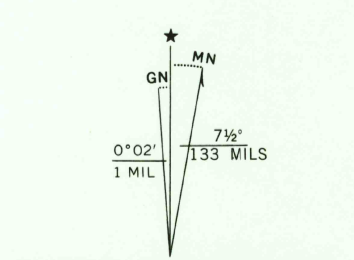

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 22 meters south and 30 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
