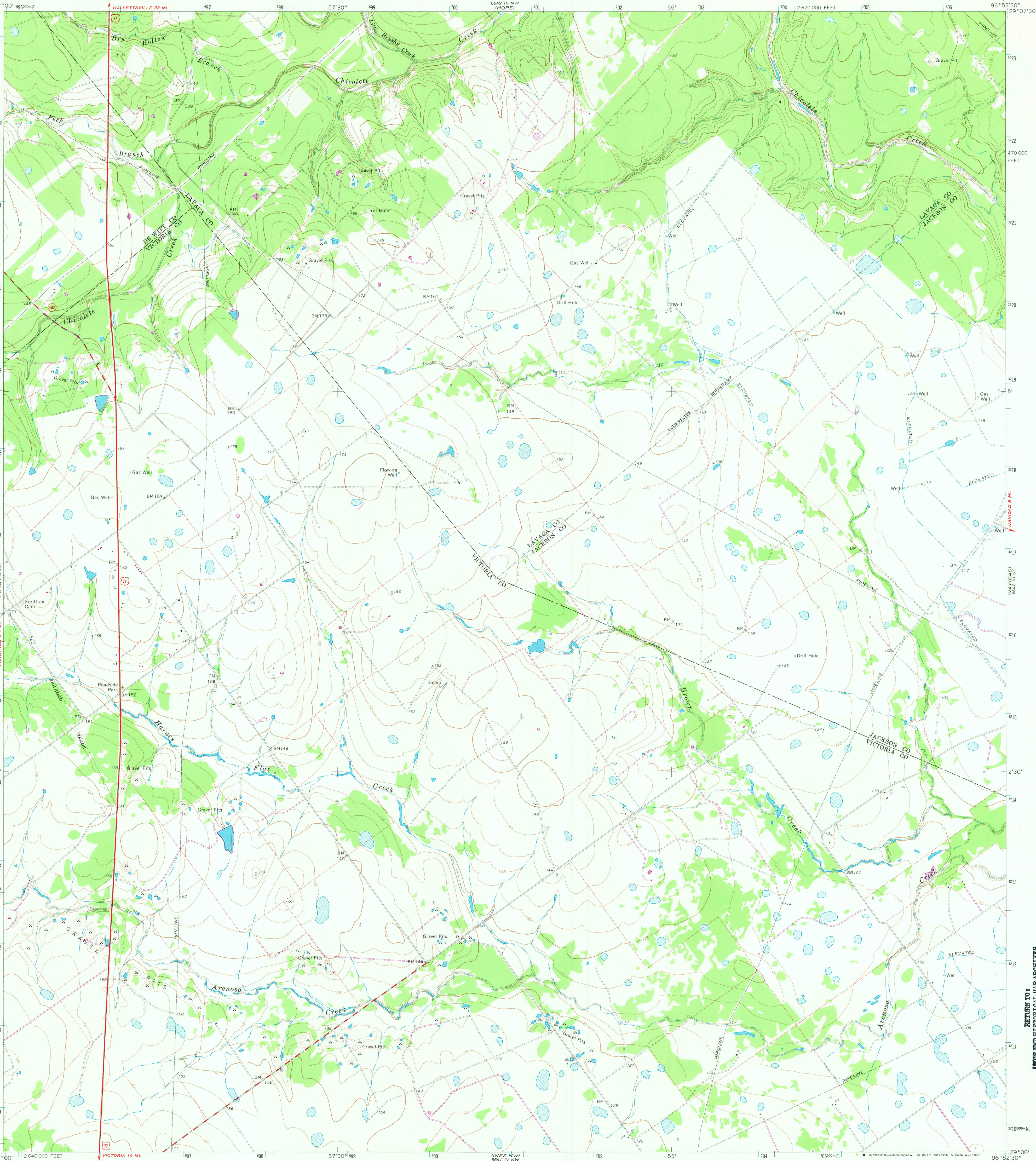

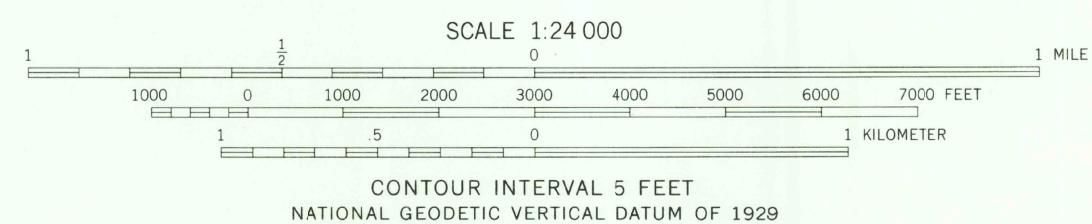
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Texas coordinate system, south central zone
