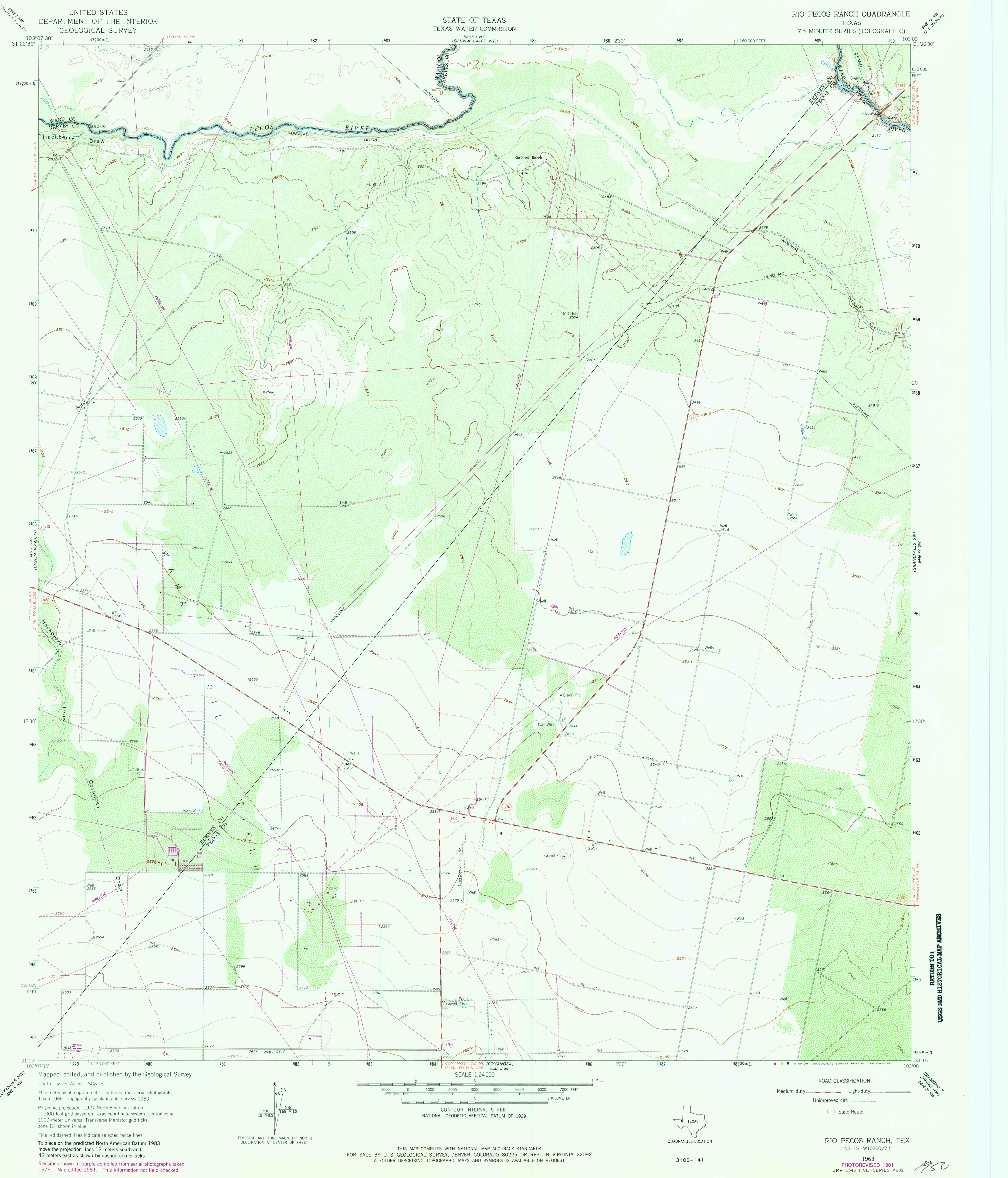

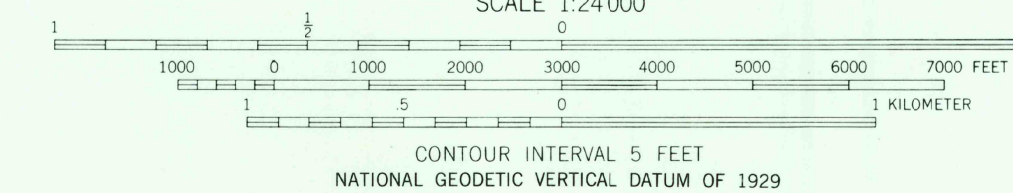
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET



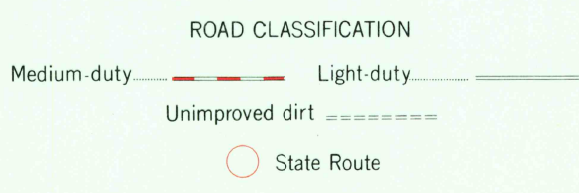
