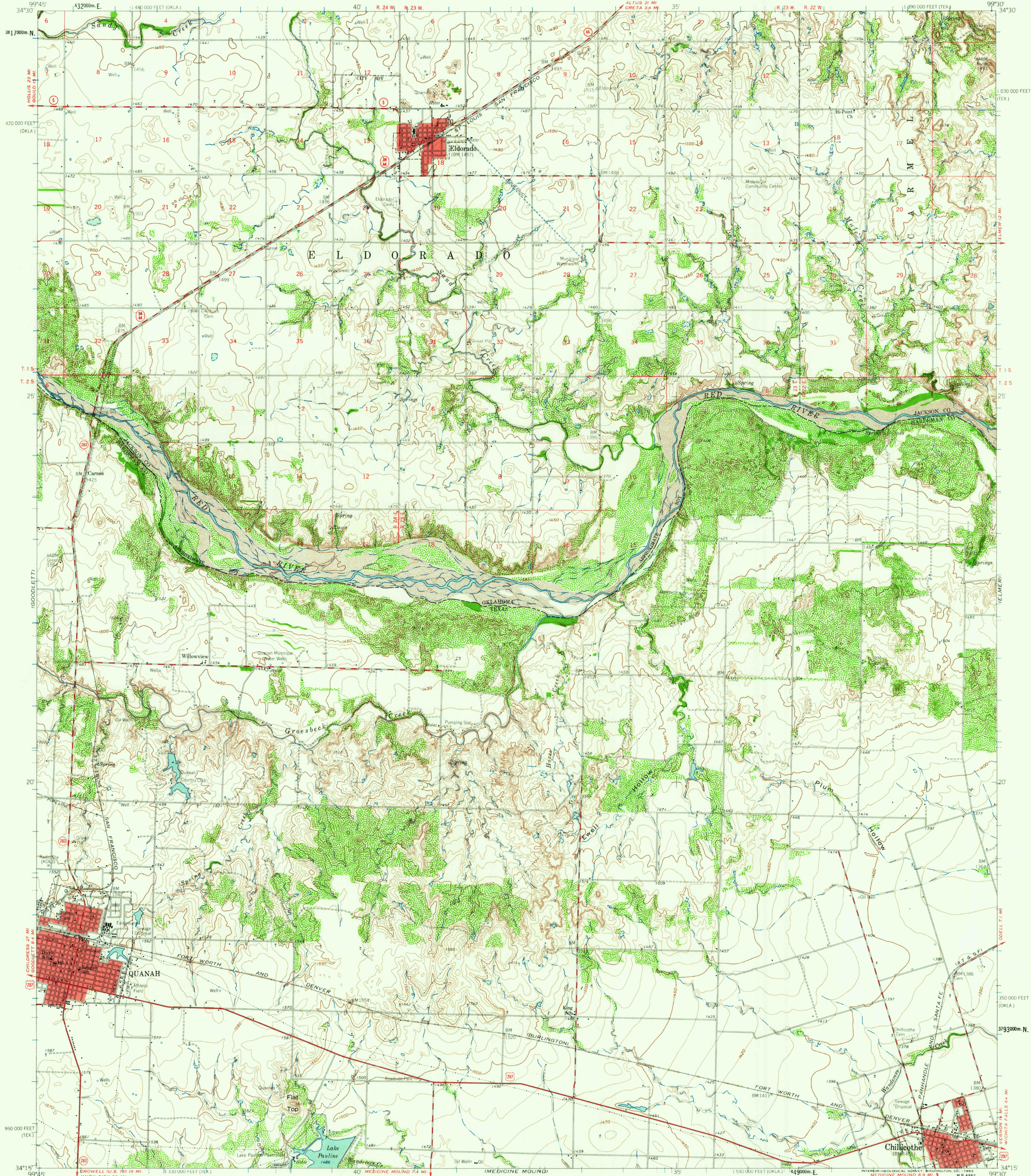

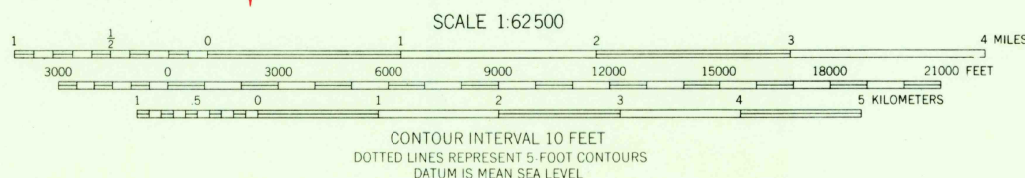

zone 14, shown in blue.

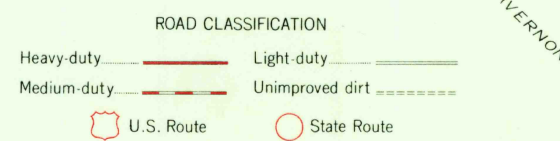
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
