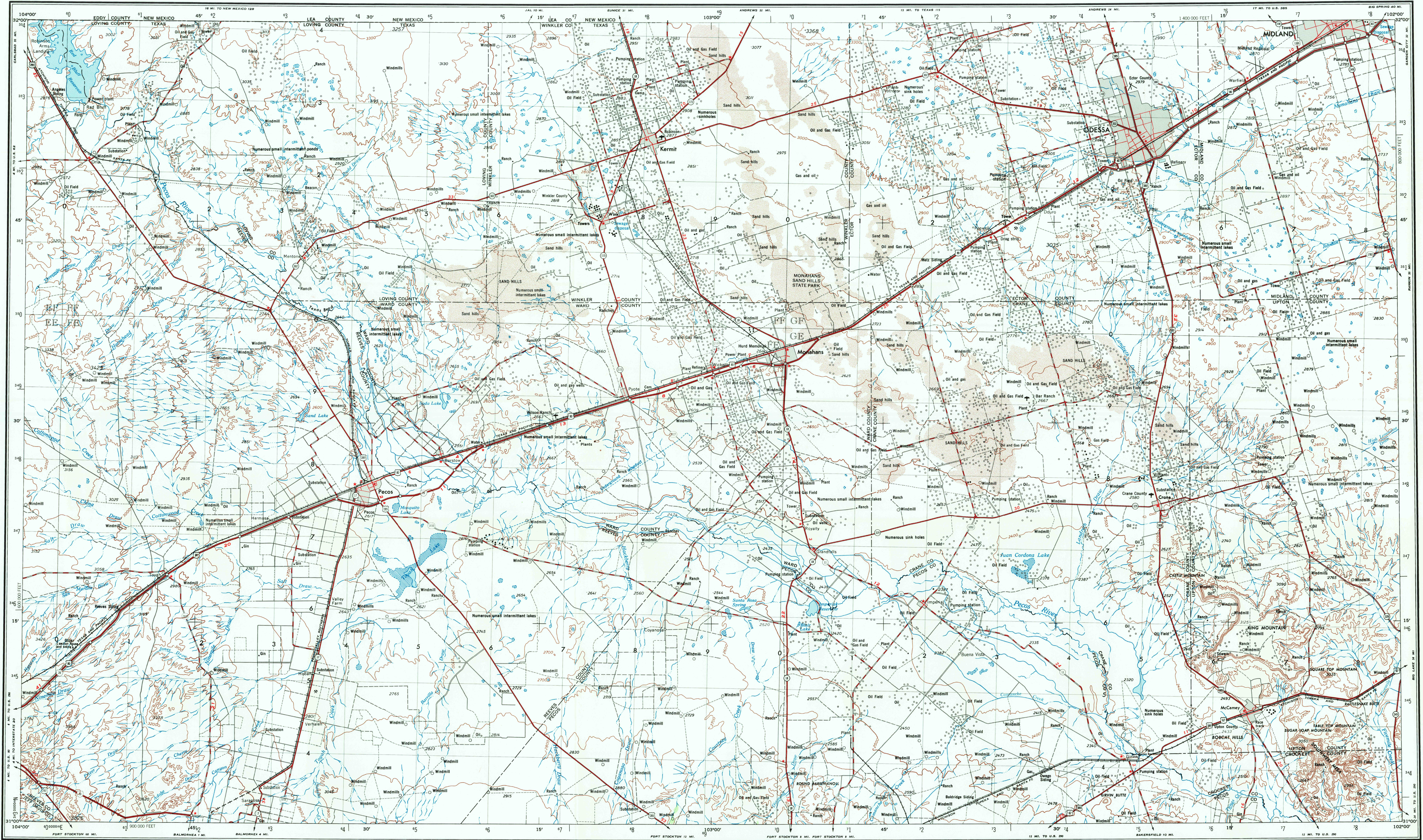

Transverse Mercator Projection, 10,000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 13. 100,000-foot grid ticks based on Texas coordinate system central zone 1927 North American Datum to place in the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 12 meters south and 42 meters east.
