

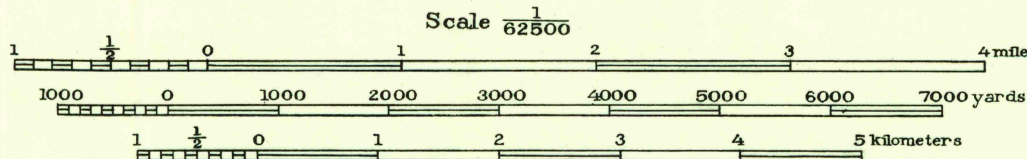
CORPS OF ENGINEERS, U.S. ARMY

GRID ZONE "D"

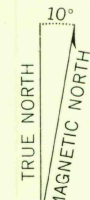
