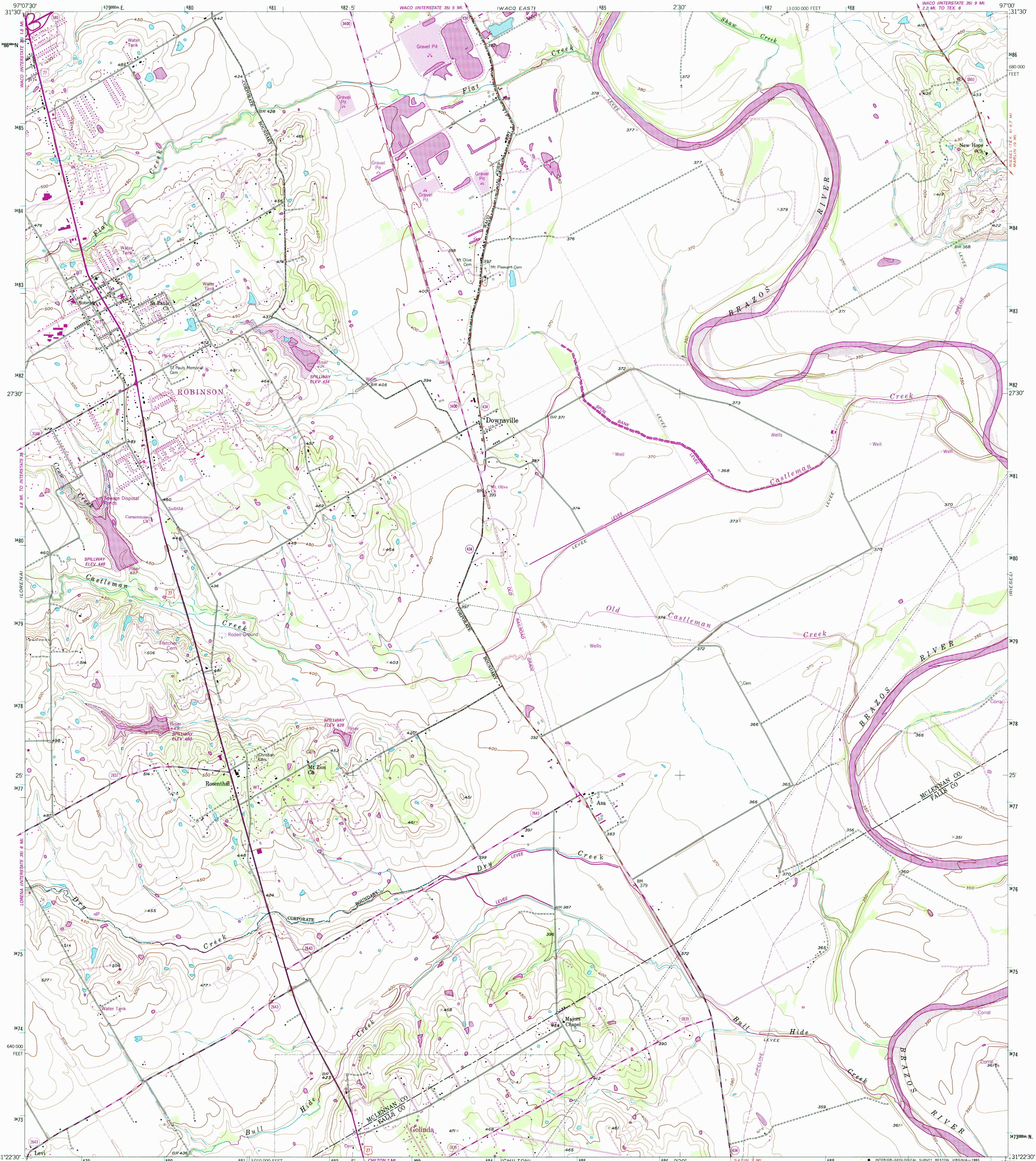

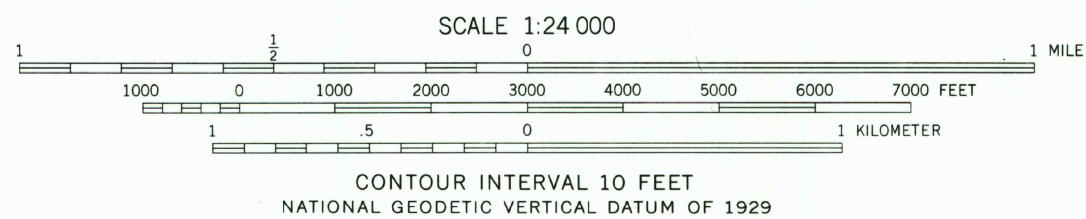
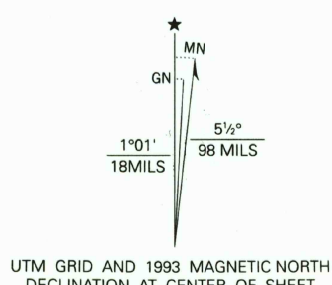
ROBINSON QUADRANGLE
