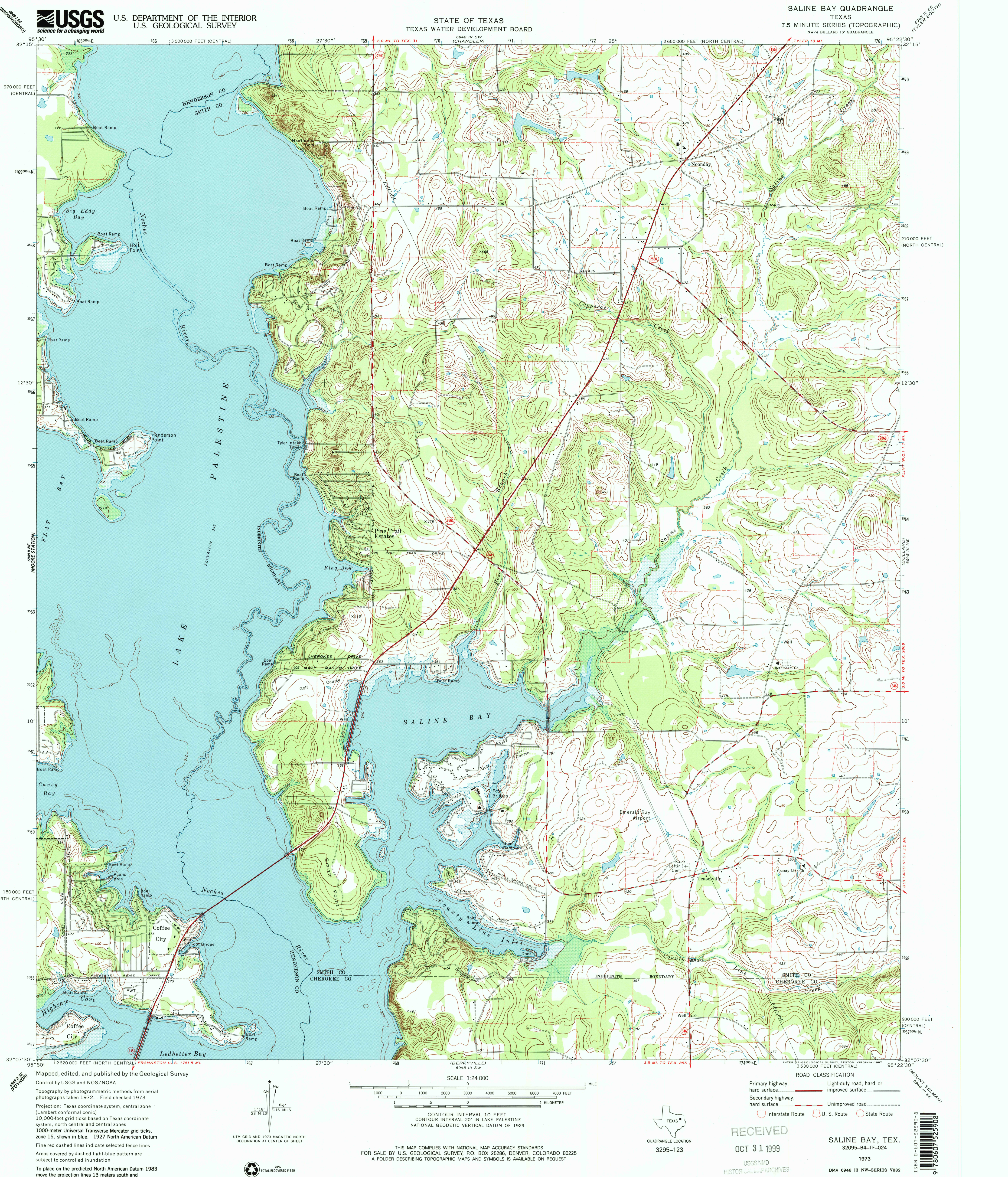




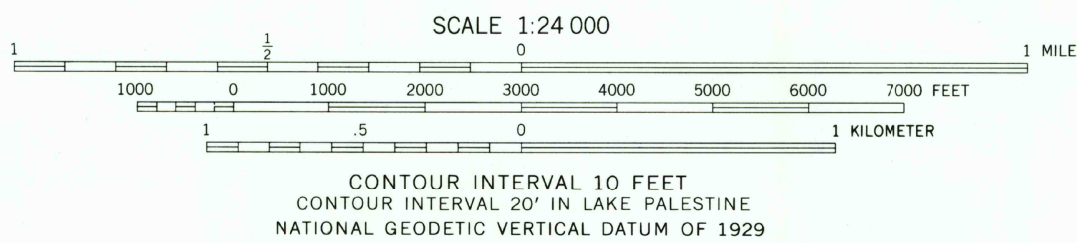
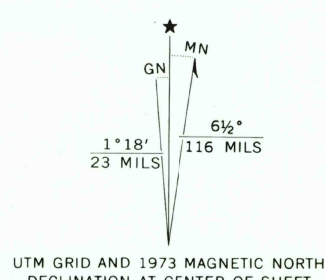

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters south and 22 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
