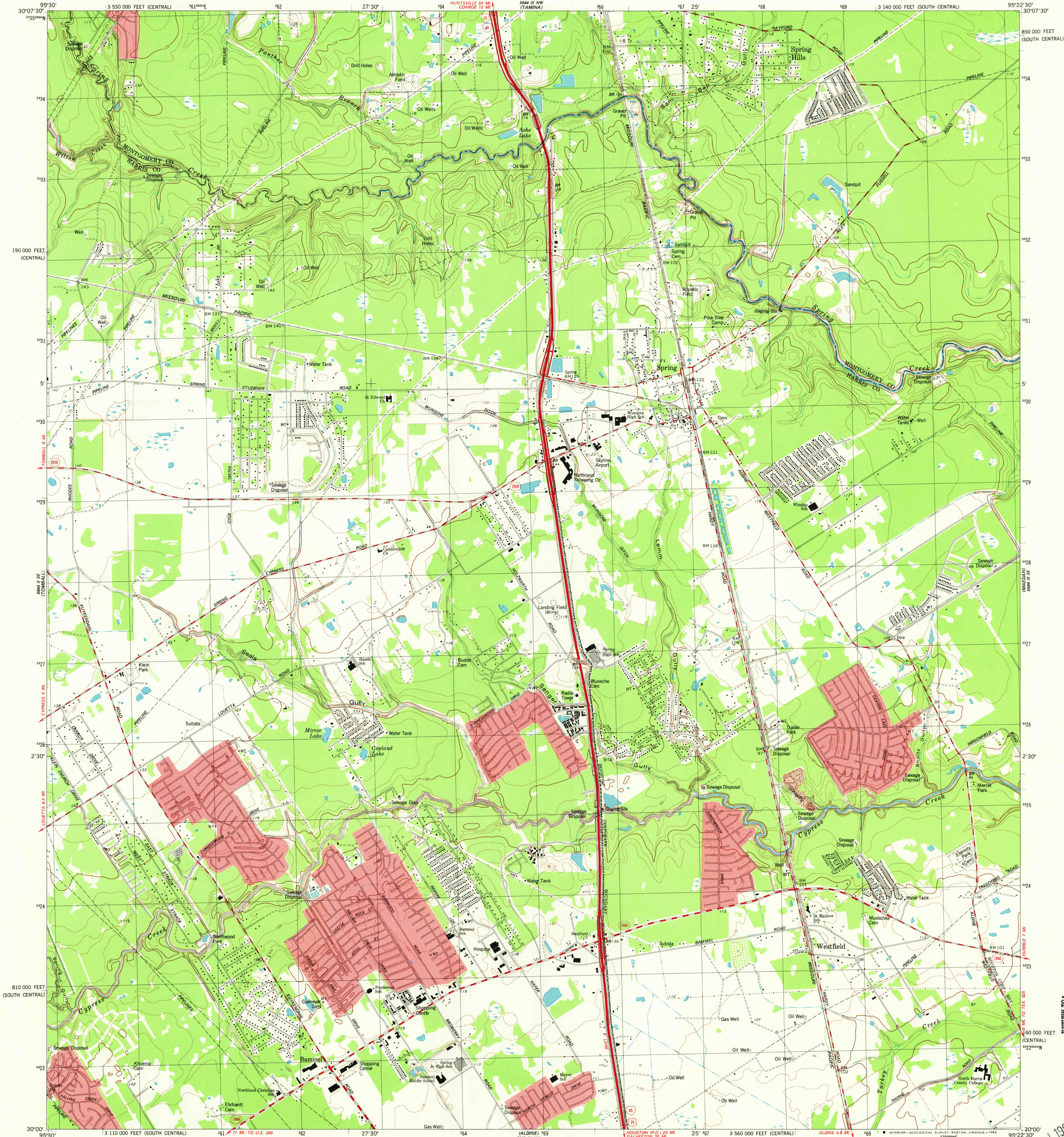

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid zone 15

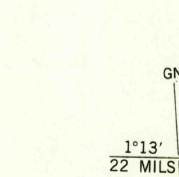

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983

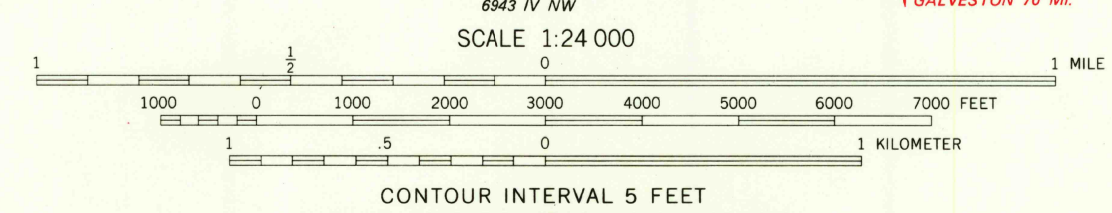
move the projection lines 19 meters south and
