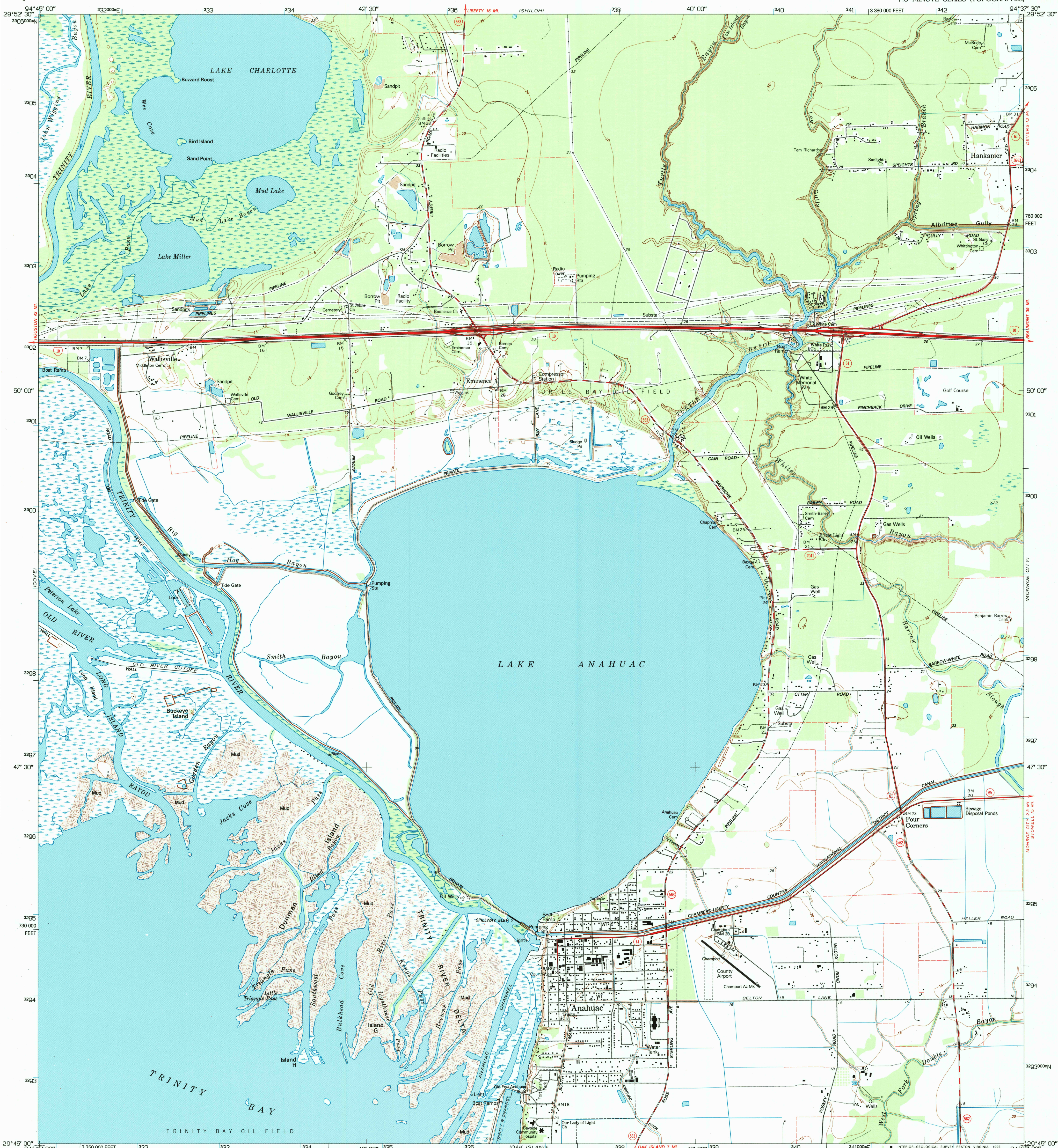

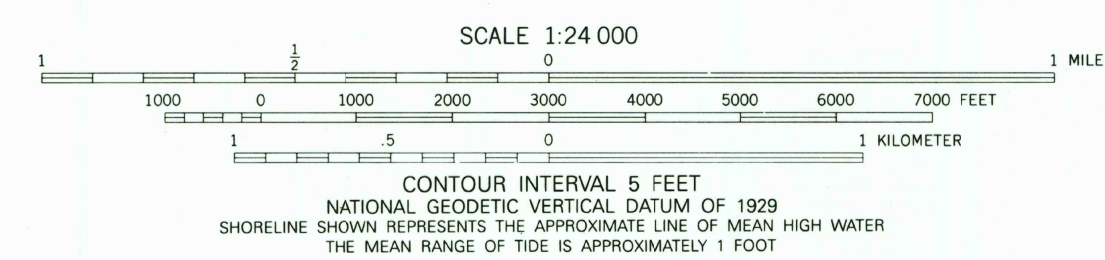
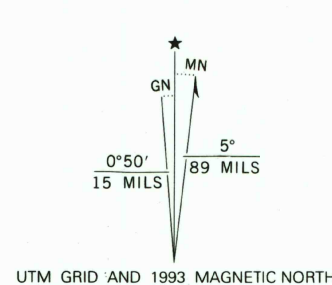

UMBERLA POINT

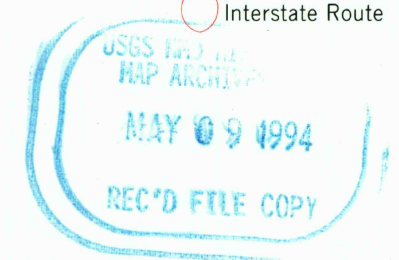
