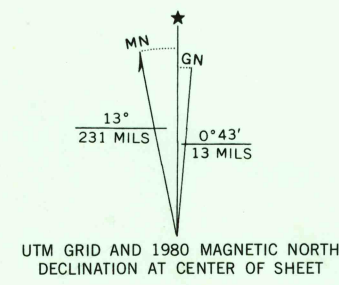

To place on the projected North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters south and 35 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
