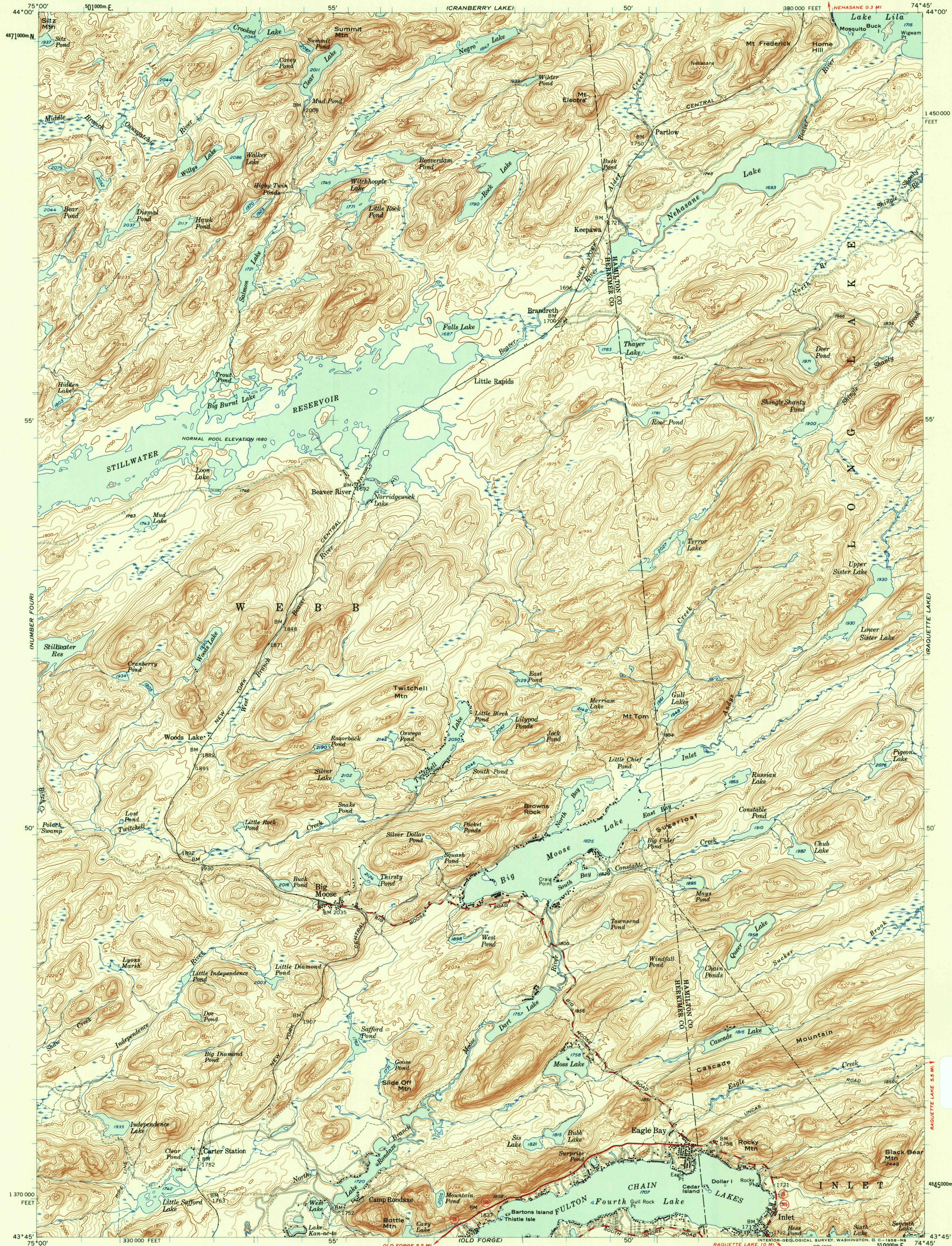

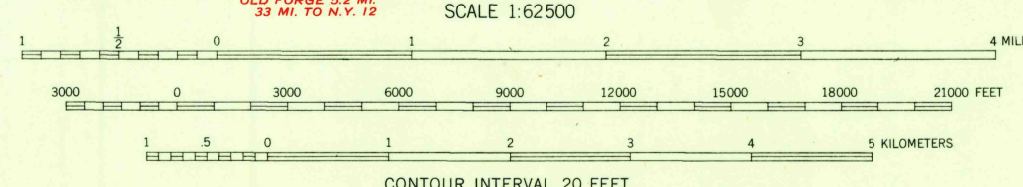
BIG MOOSE QUADRANGLE
