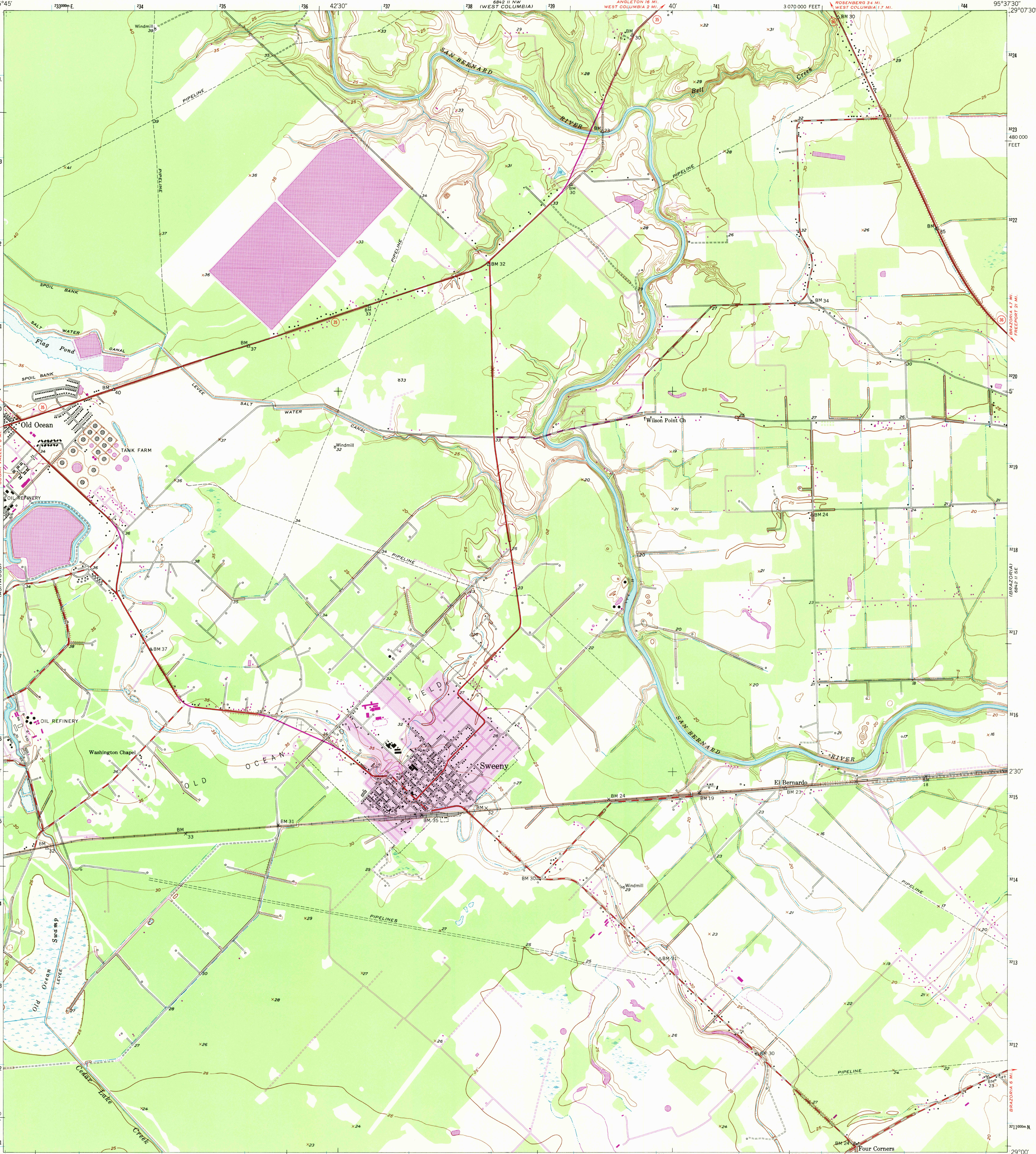

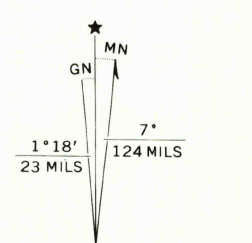

shown in blue

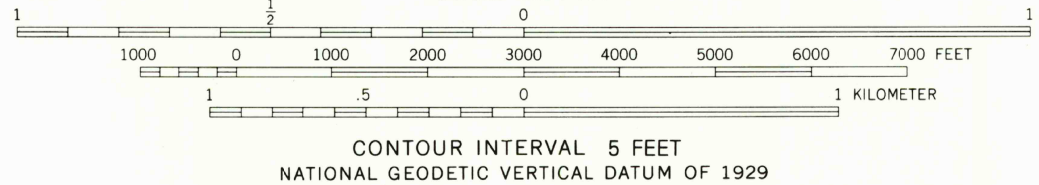
The difference between 1927 North American Datum and North

DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET



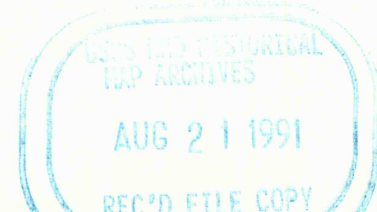
