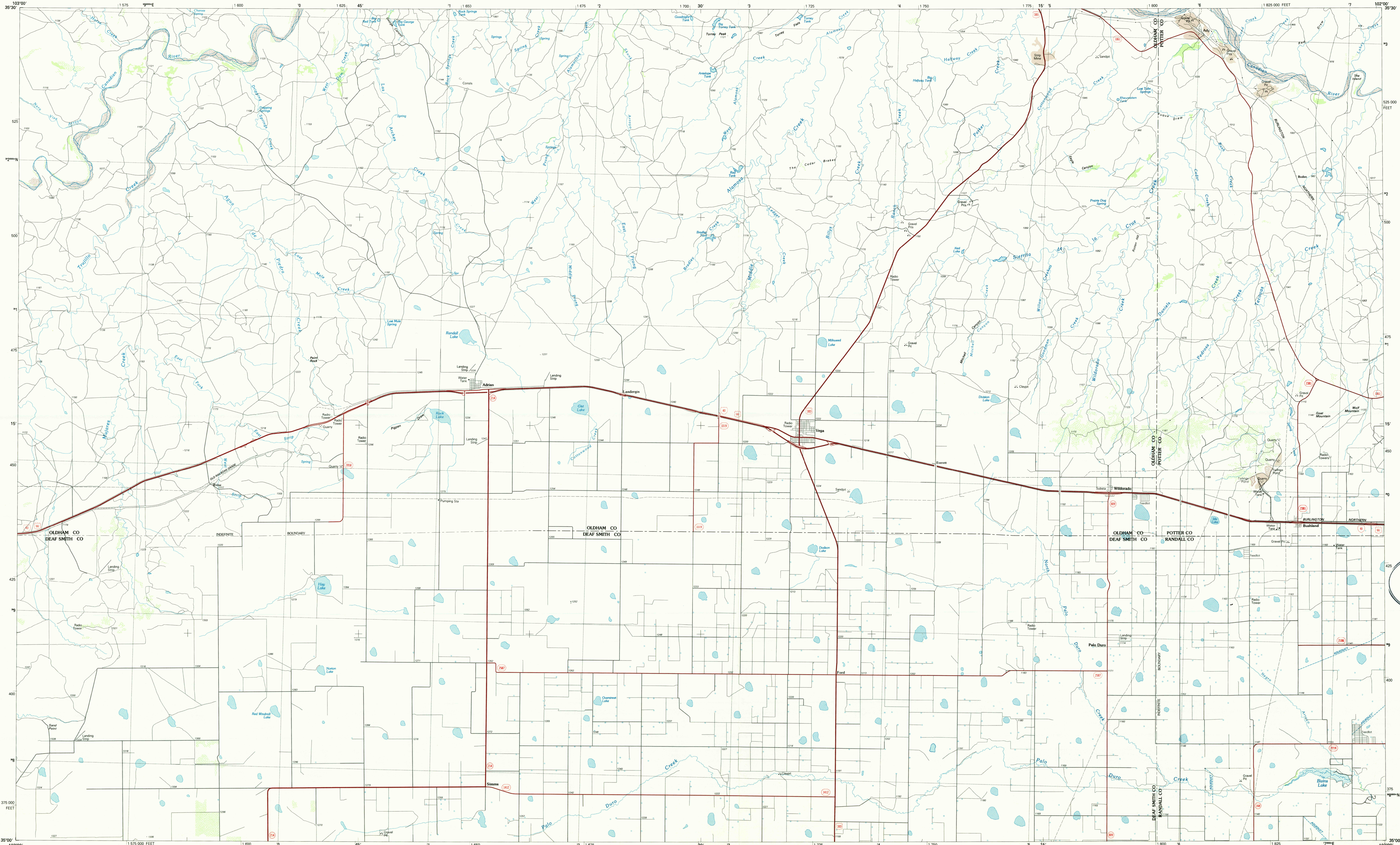
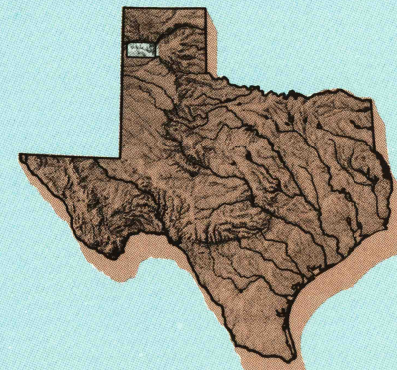




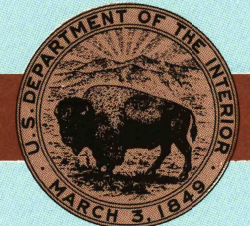
Vega TEXAS
