

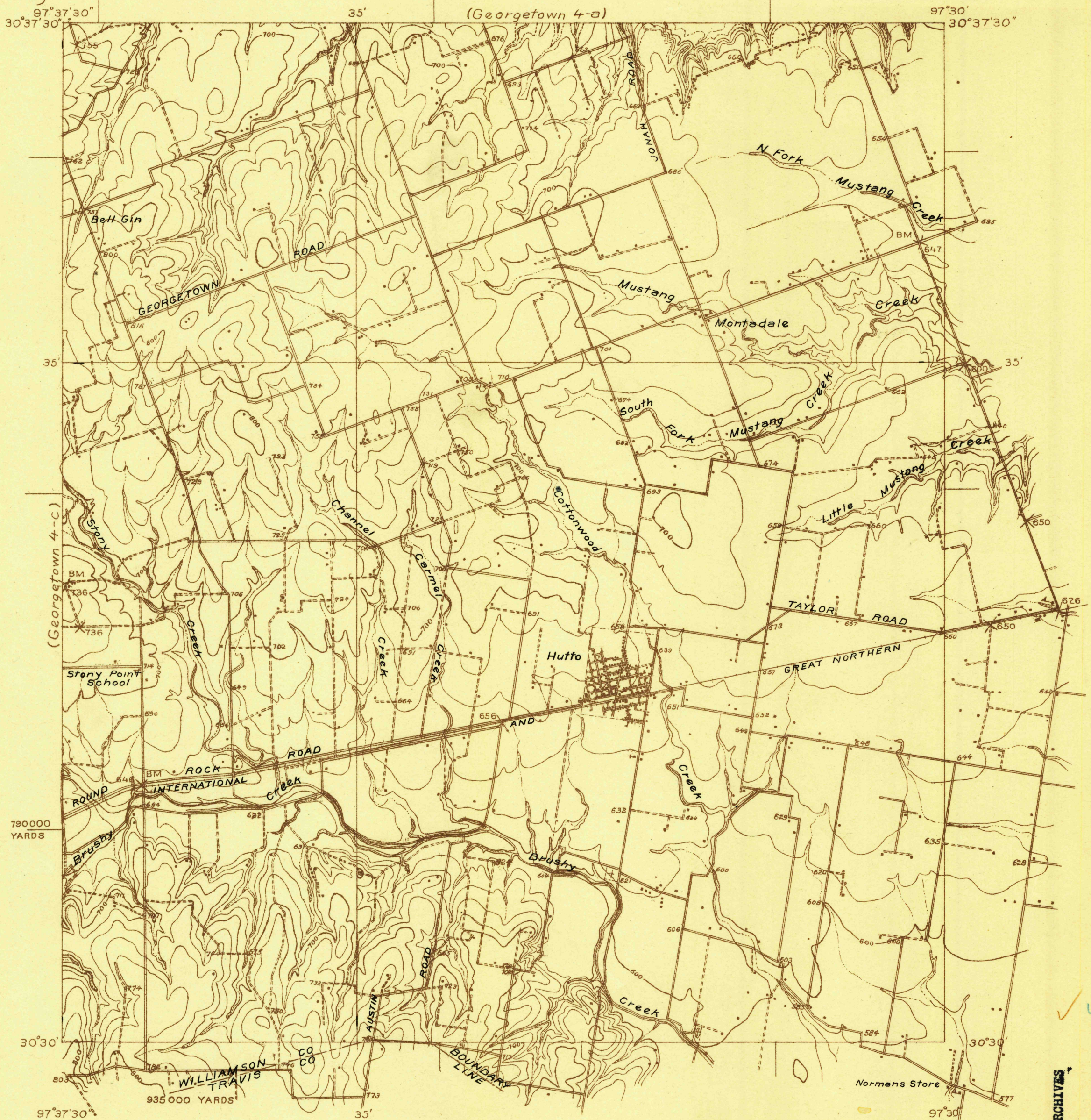

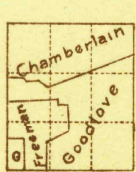

GEORGETOWN 4-d QUADRANGLE

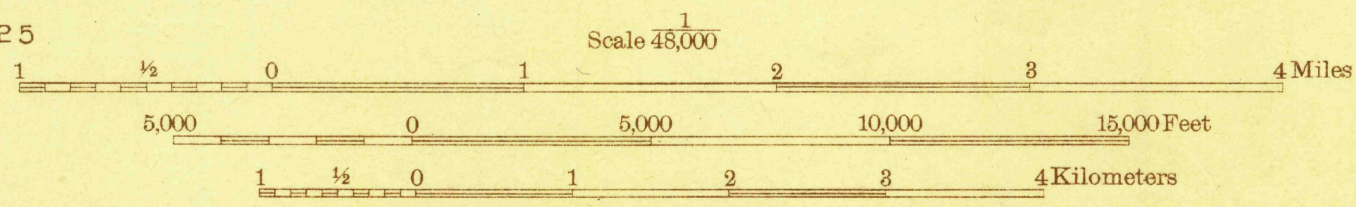

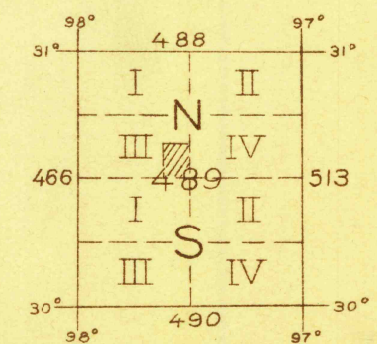
Polyconic projection. North American datum

DECLINATION, 1925

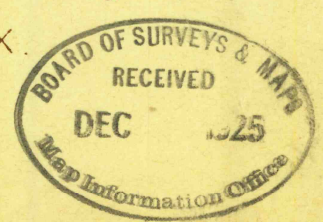
