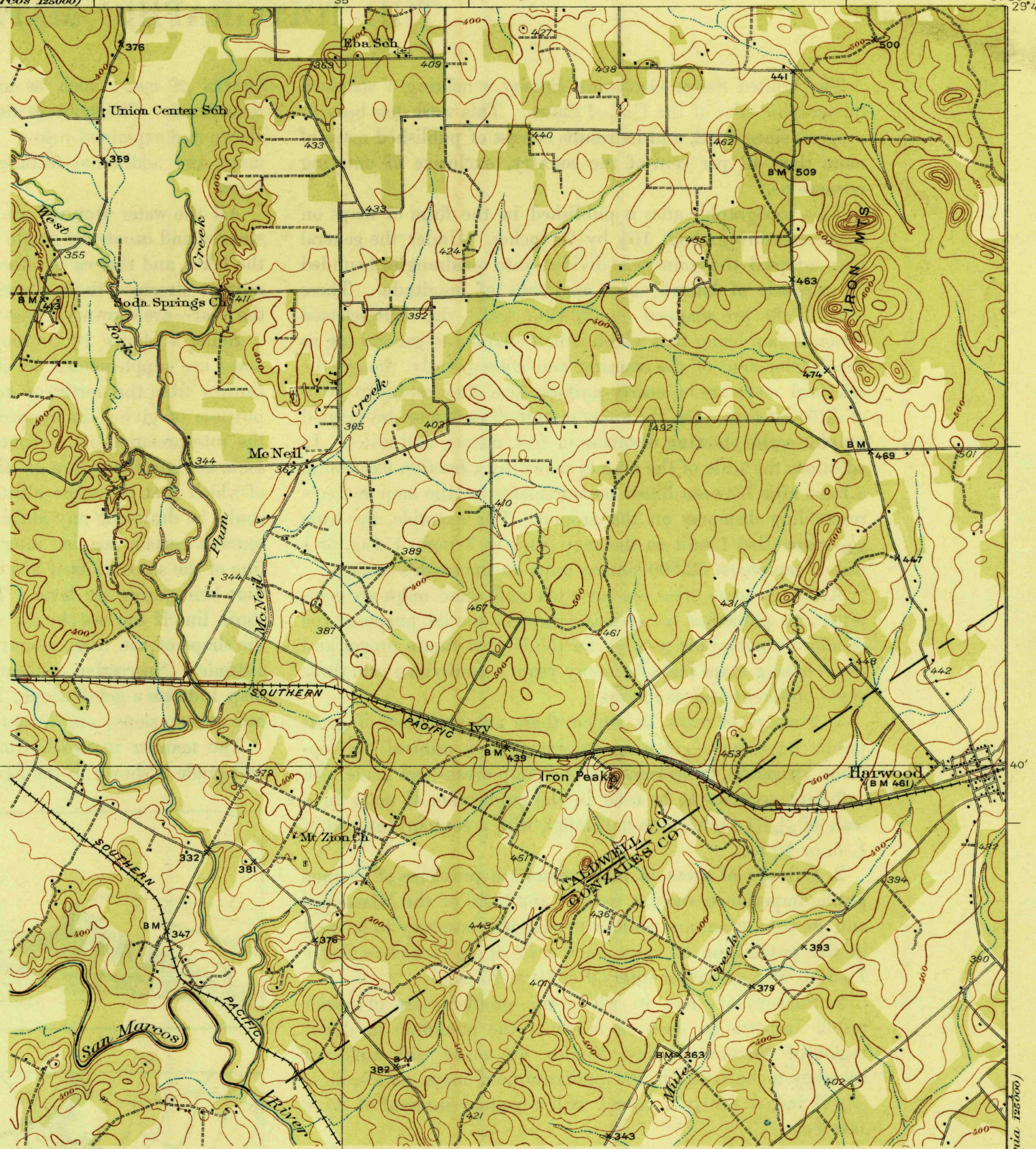

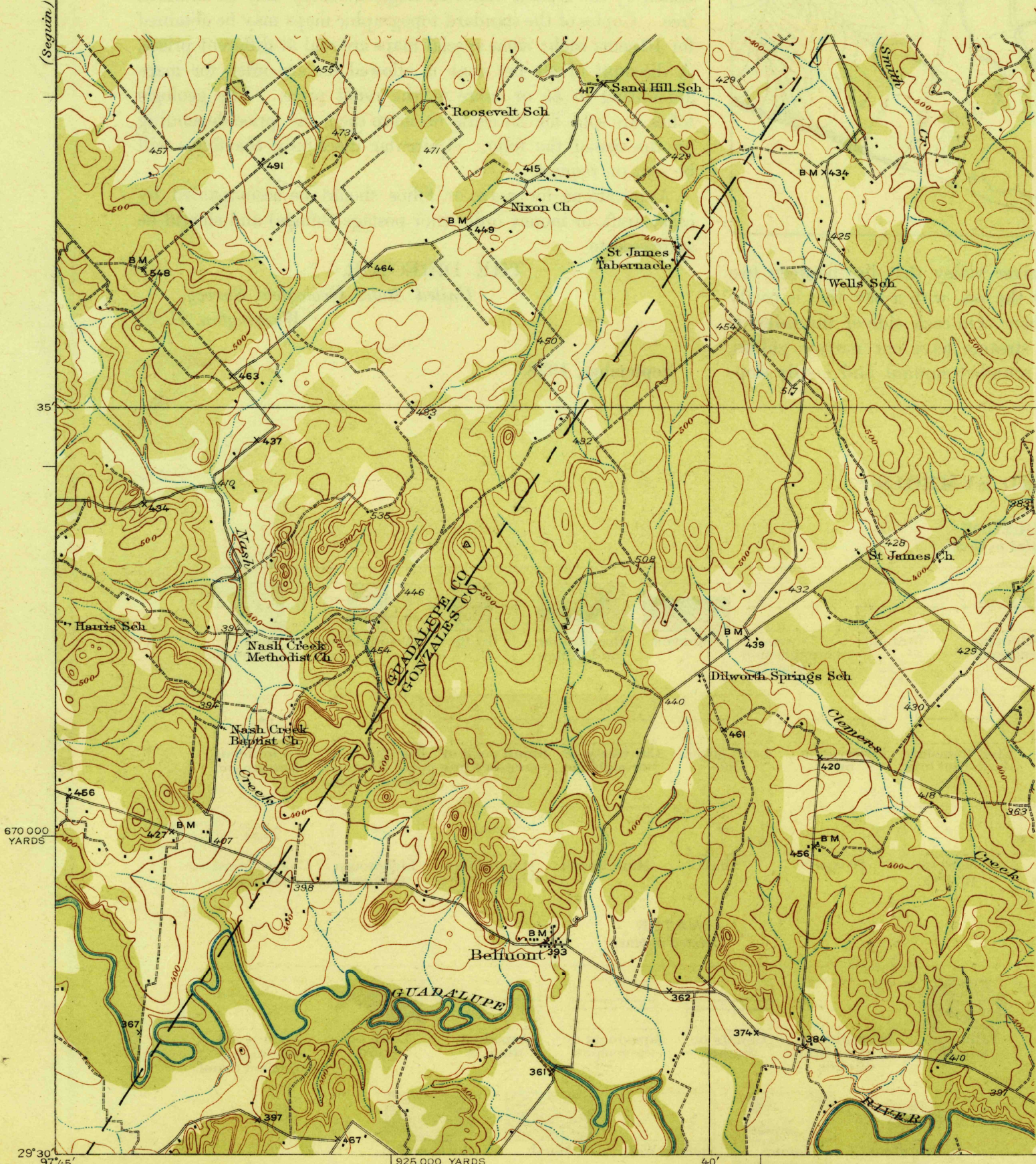
THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF SAN MARCOS

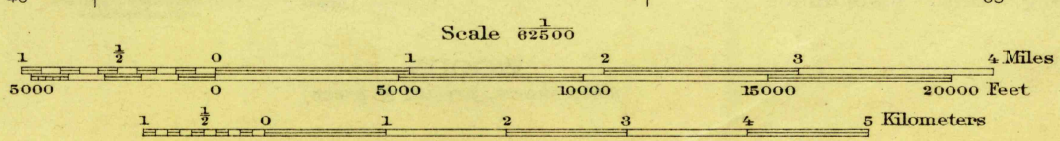
THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE MAP OF SAN MARCOS
