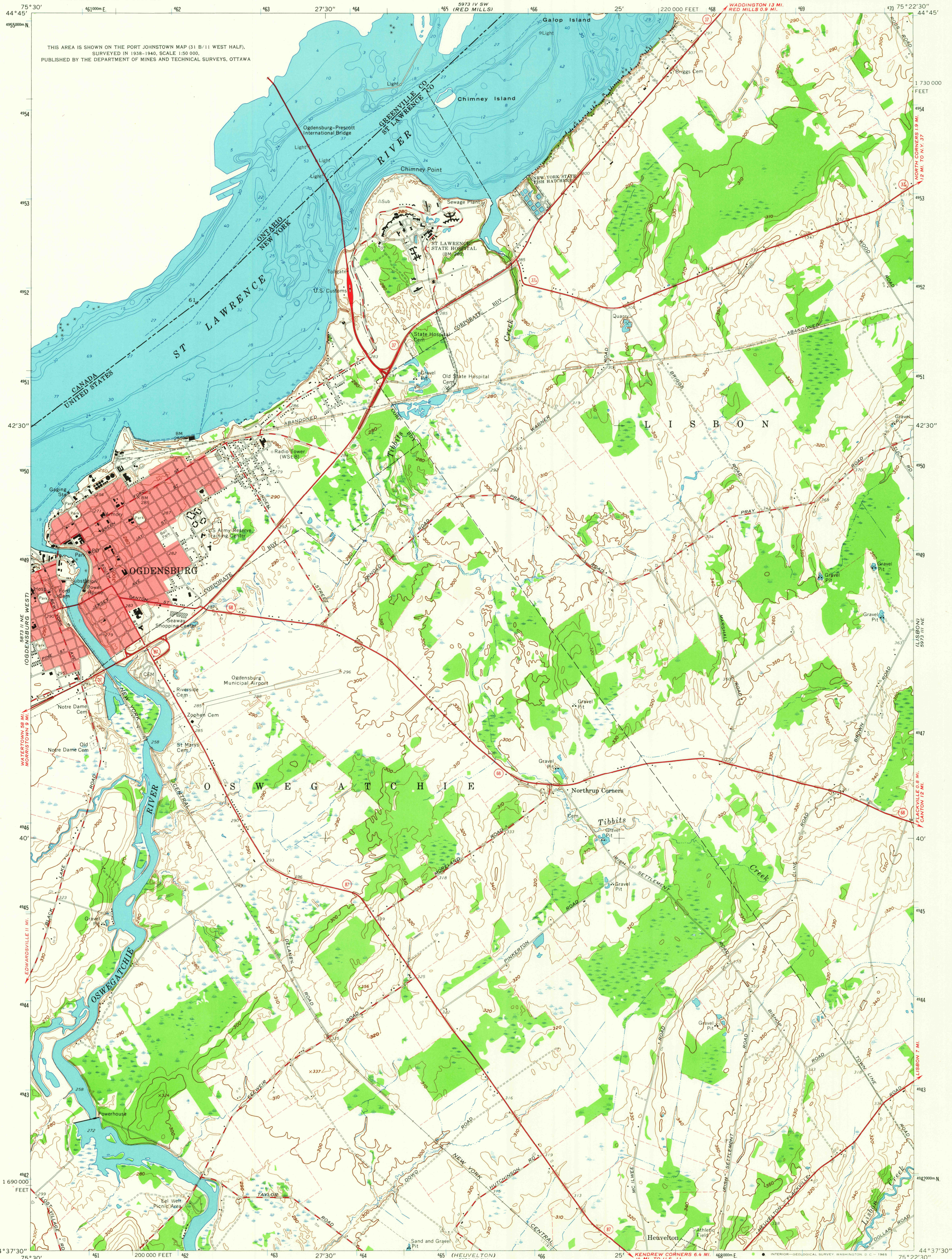
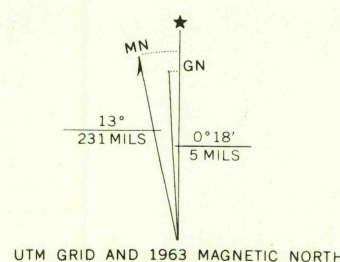


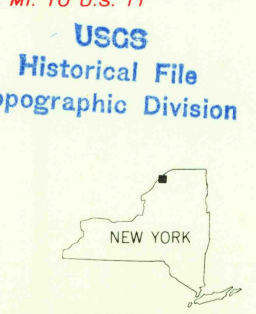


THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE PORT JOHNS TOWN MAP (31 B/11 WEST HALF),
