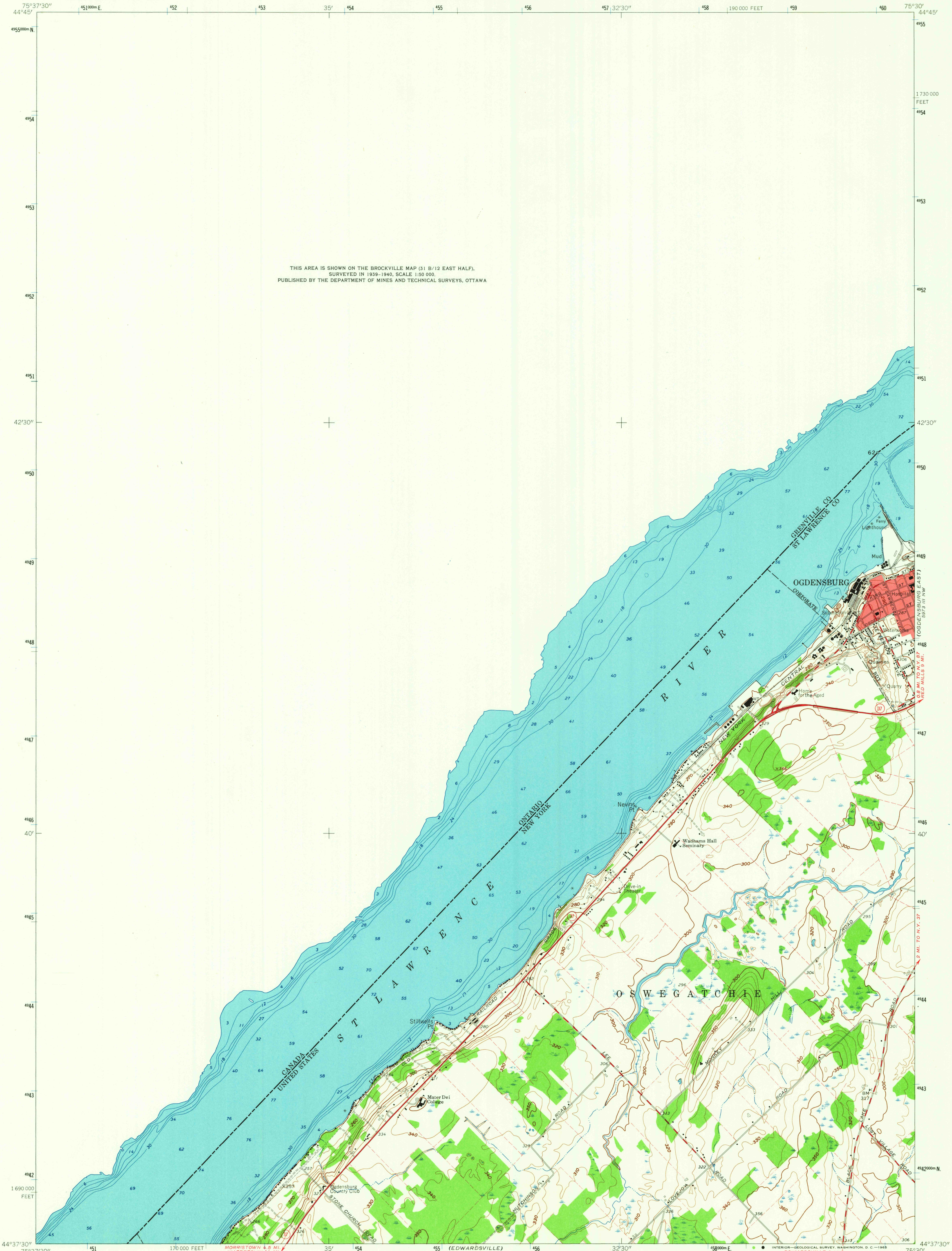
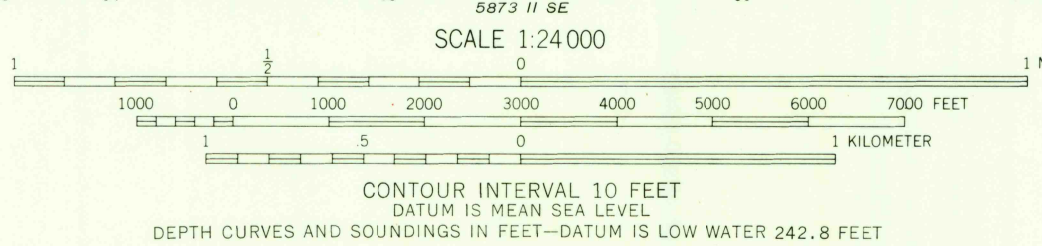
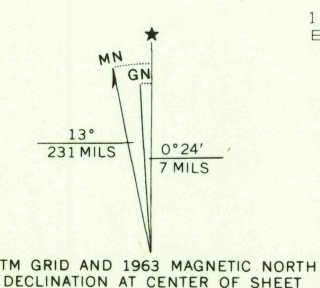




THIS AREA IS SHOWN ON THE BROCKVILLE MAP (31 B/12 EAST HALF),
