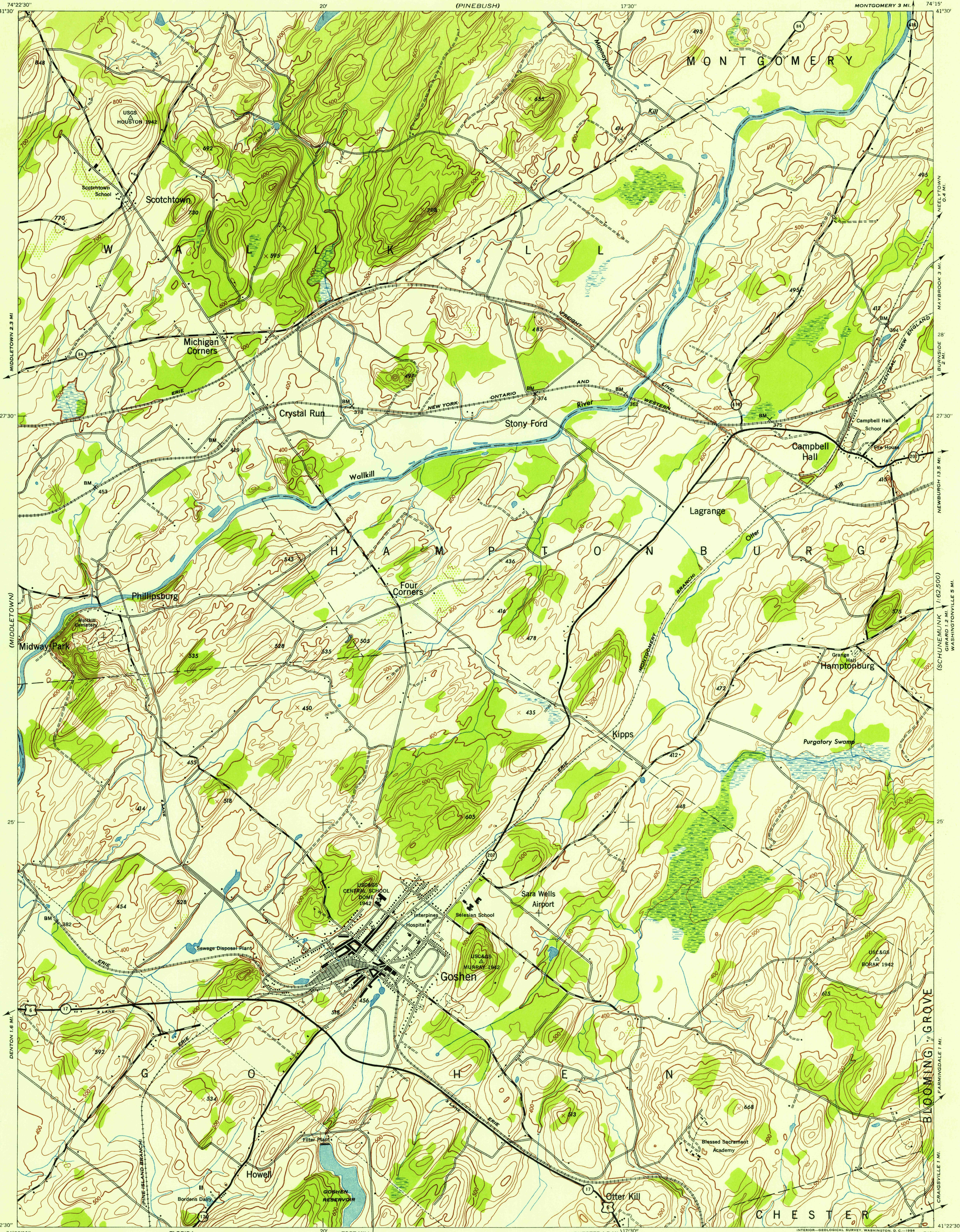
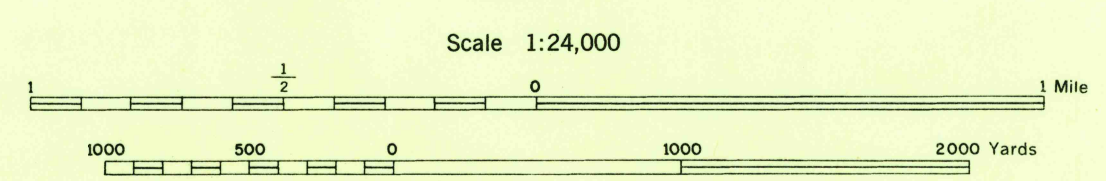

More than two lanes indicated by note along road with tick at point of change.

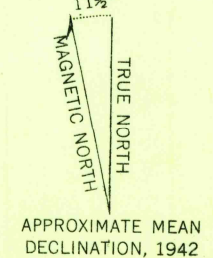


CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 FEET
