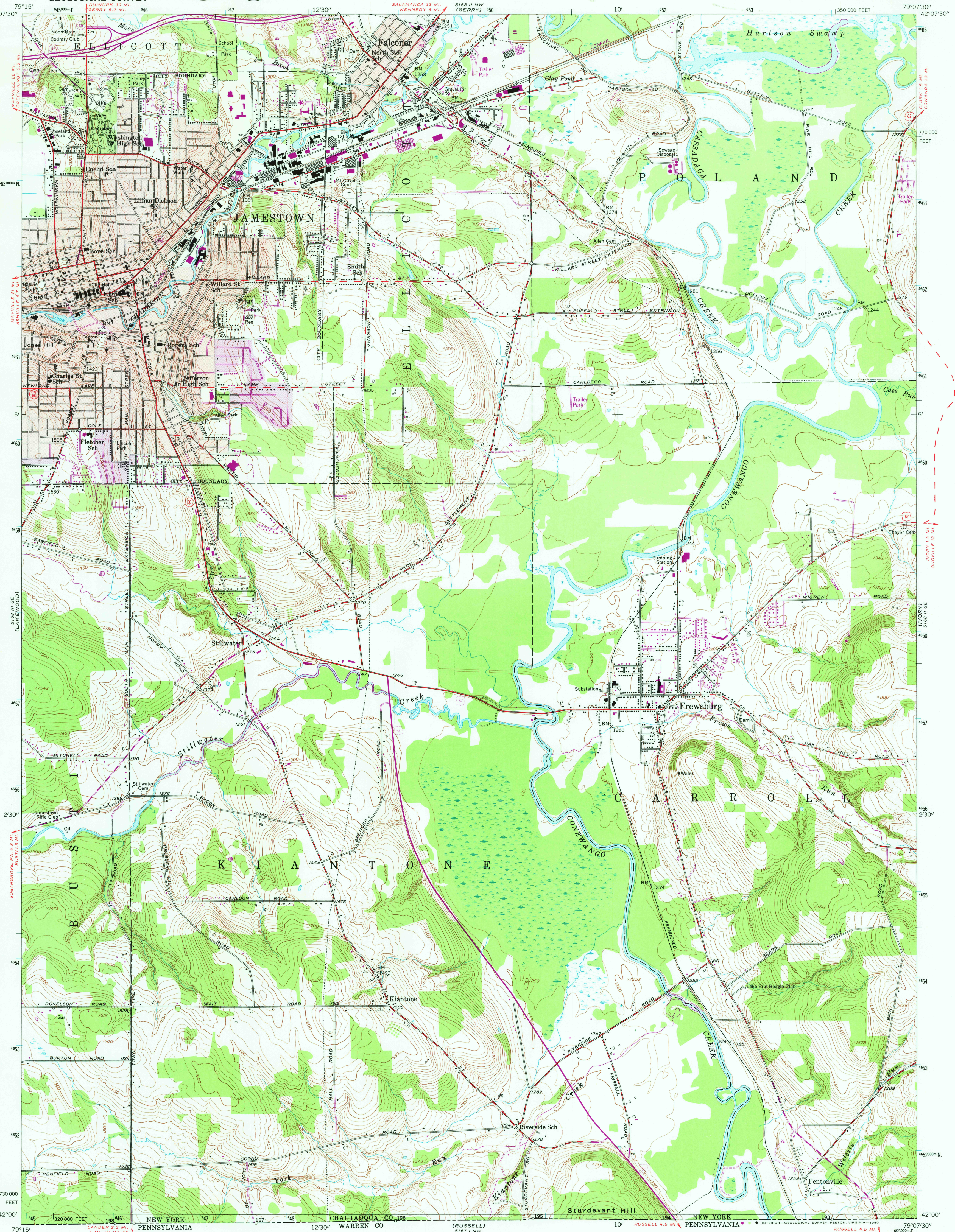

10,000-foot grid based on New York coordinate system, west zone

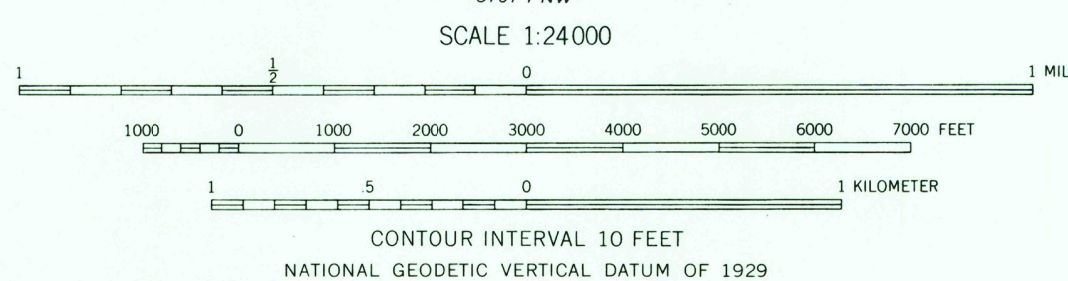
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
