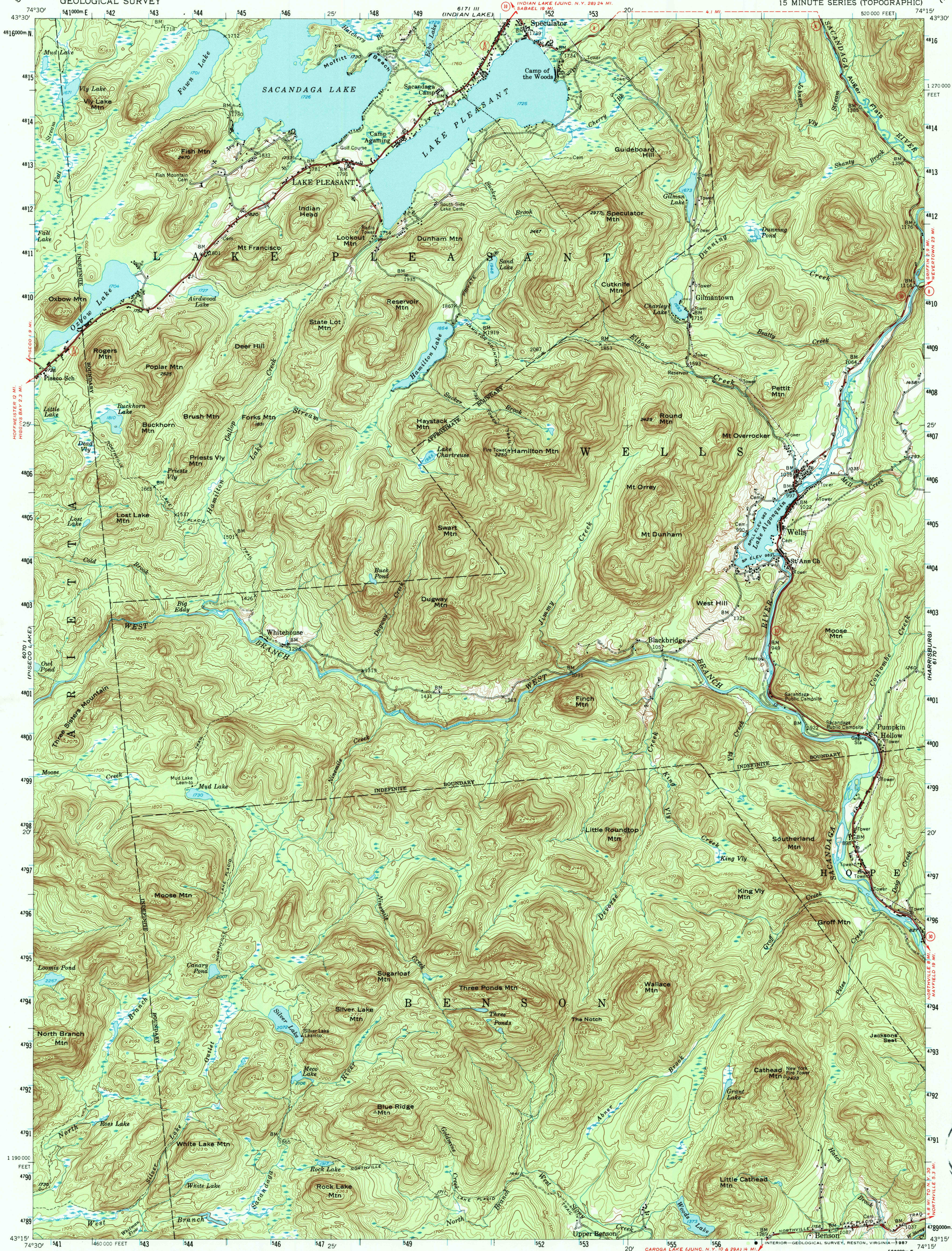


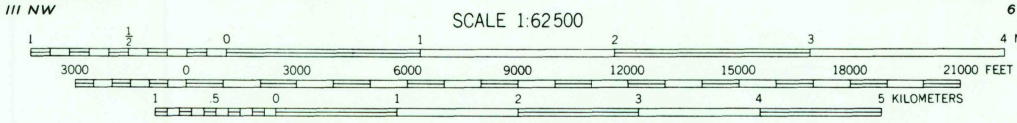
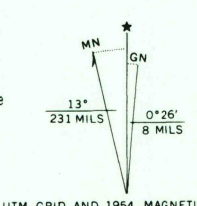

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983,
move the projection lines 3 meters south and 32 meters west
