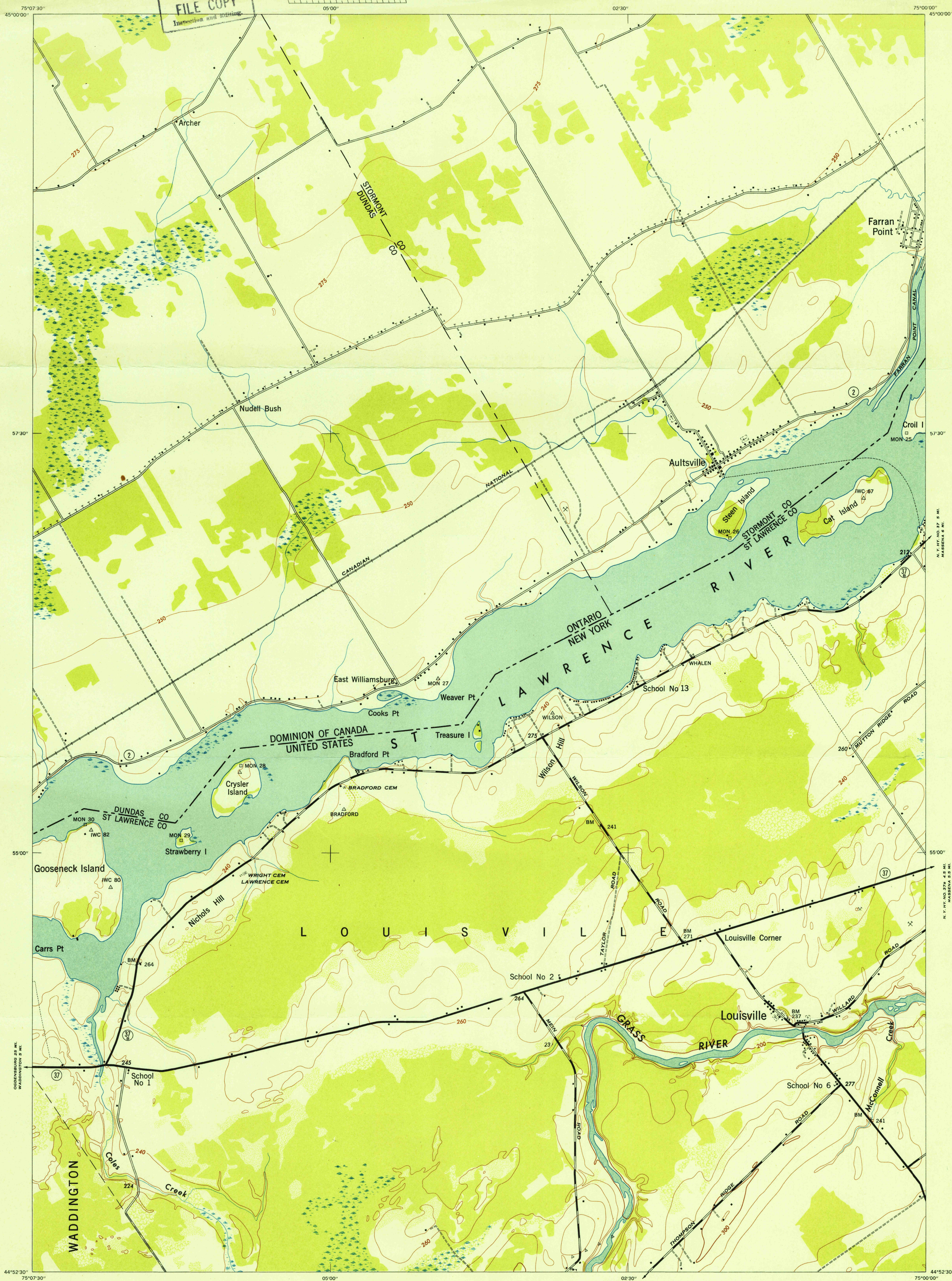
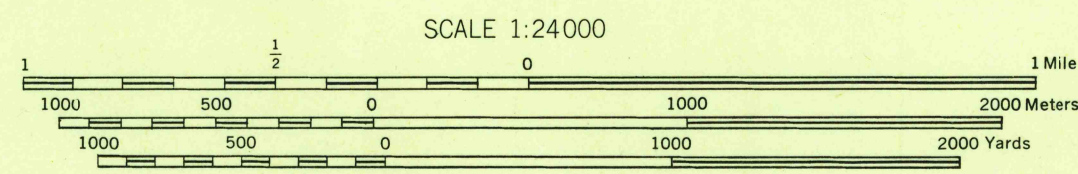

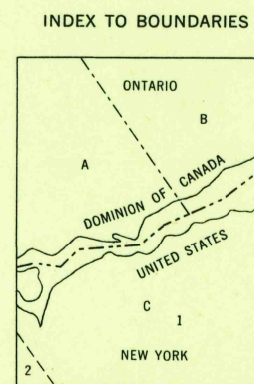


CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 FEET IN U. S.

DATUM IS MEAN SEA LEVEL

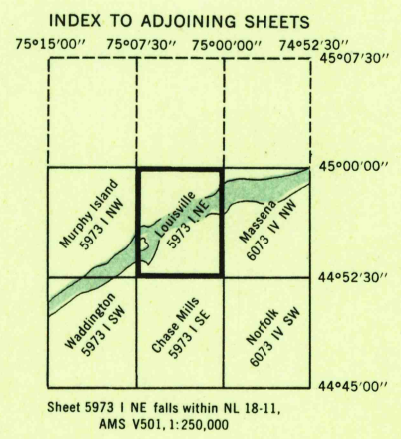
POLYCONIC PROJECTION
