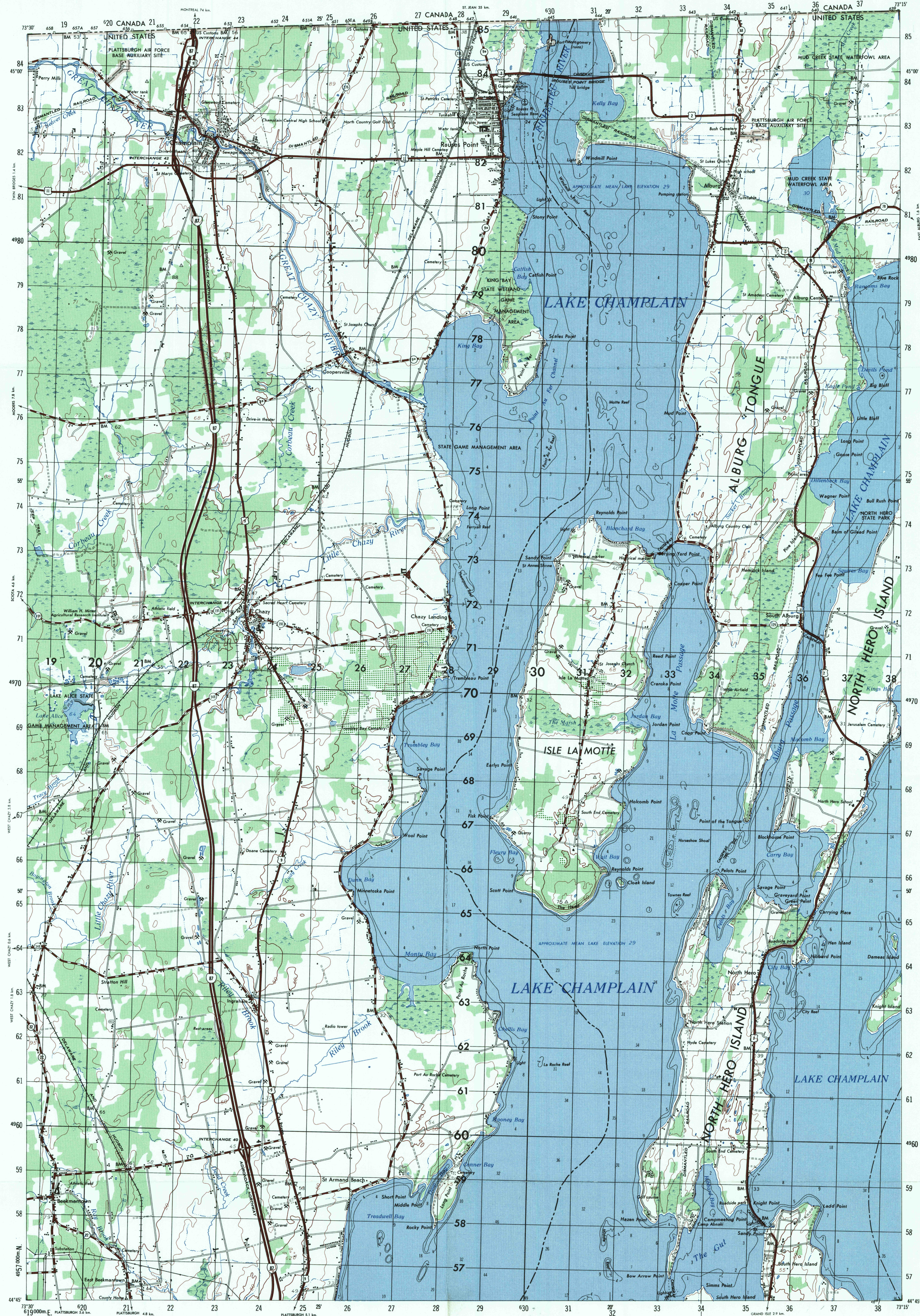


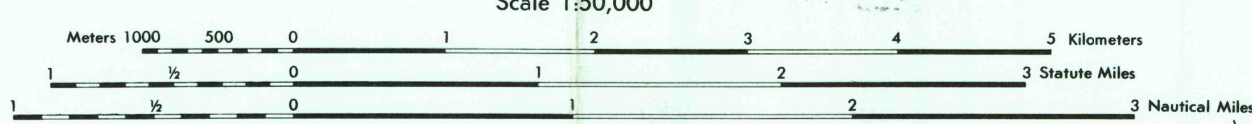
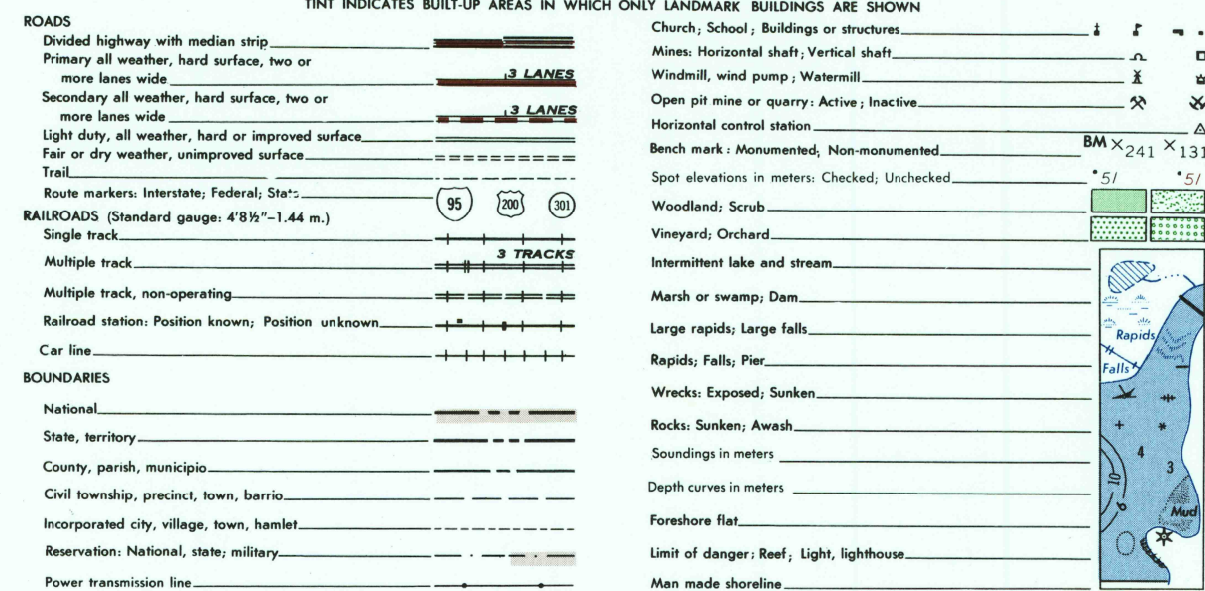

TINT INDICATES BUILT-UP AREAS IN WHICH ONLY LANDMARK BUILDINGS ARE SHOWN

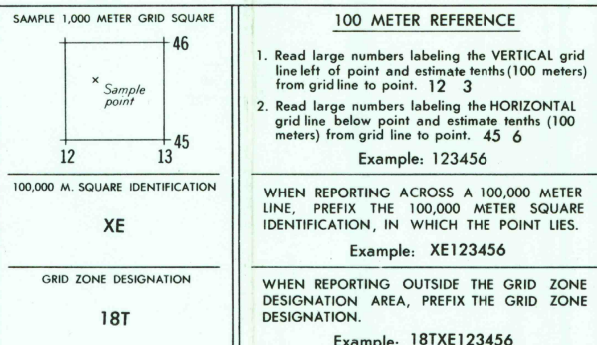

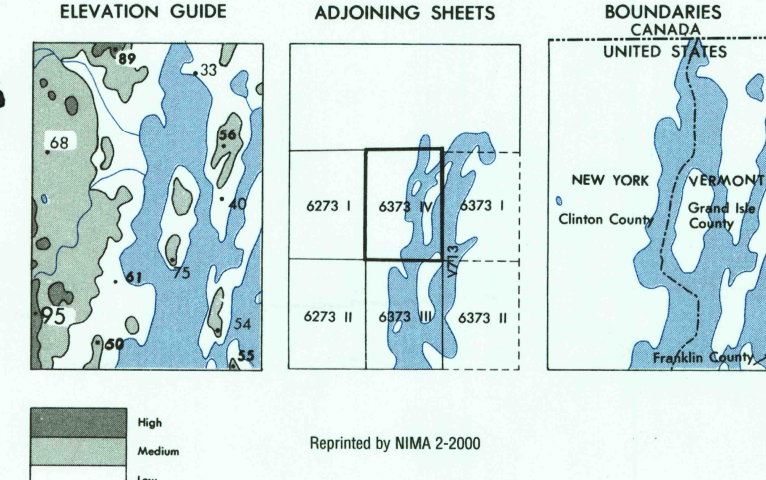
