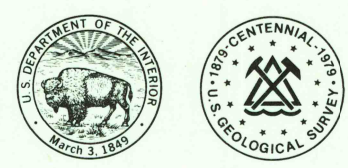


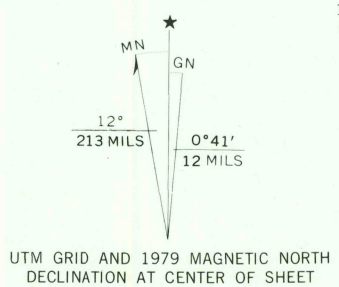

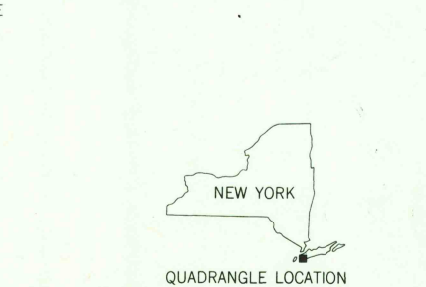
CONEY ISLAND QUADRANGLE
