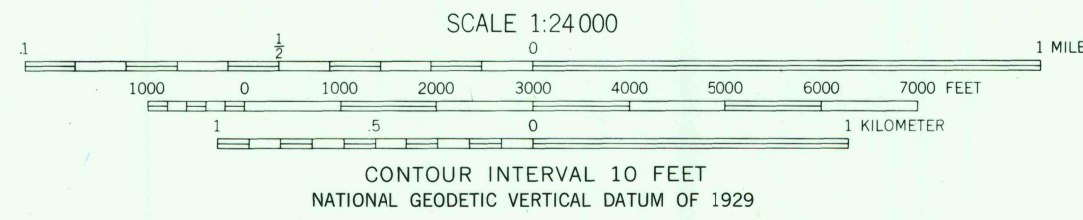
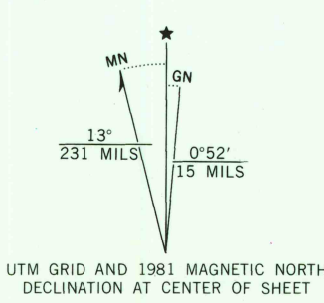

Polycyclic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on New York coordinate system, east zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters south and 36 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally shown on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.

Revisions shown in purple and woodland compiled from aerial photographs taken 1981 and other sources. This information not field checked. Map edited 1981.
