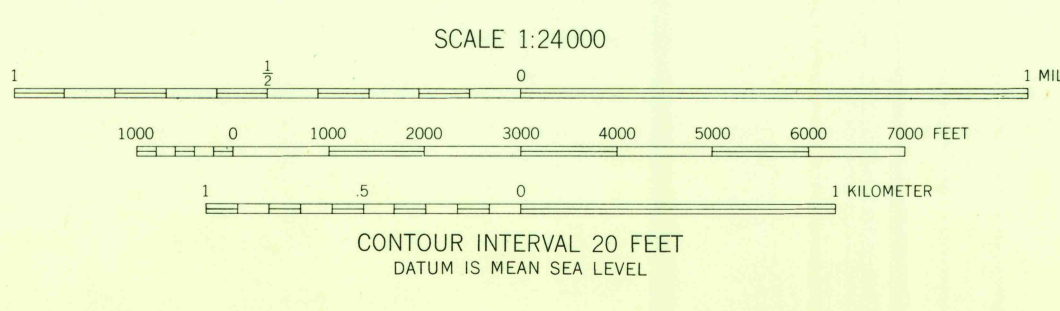


ROTTERDAM JUNCTION
