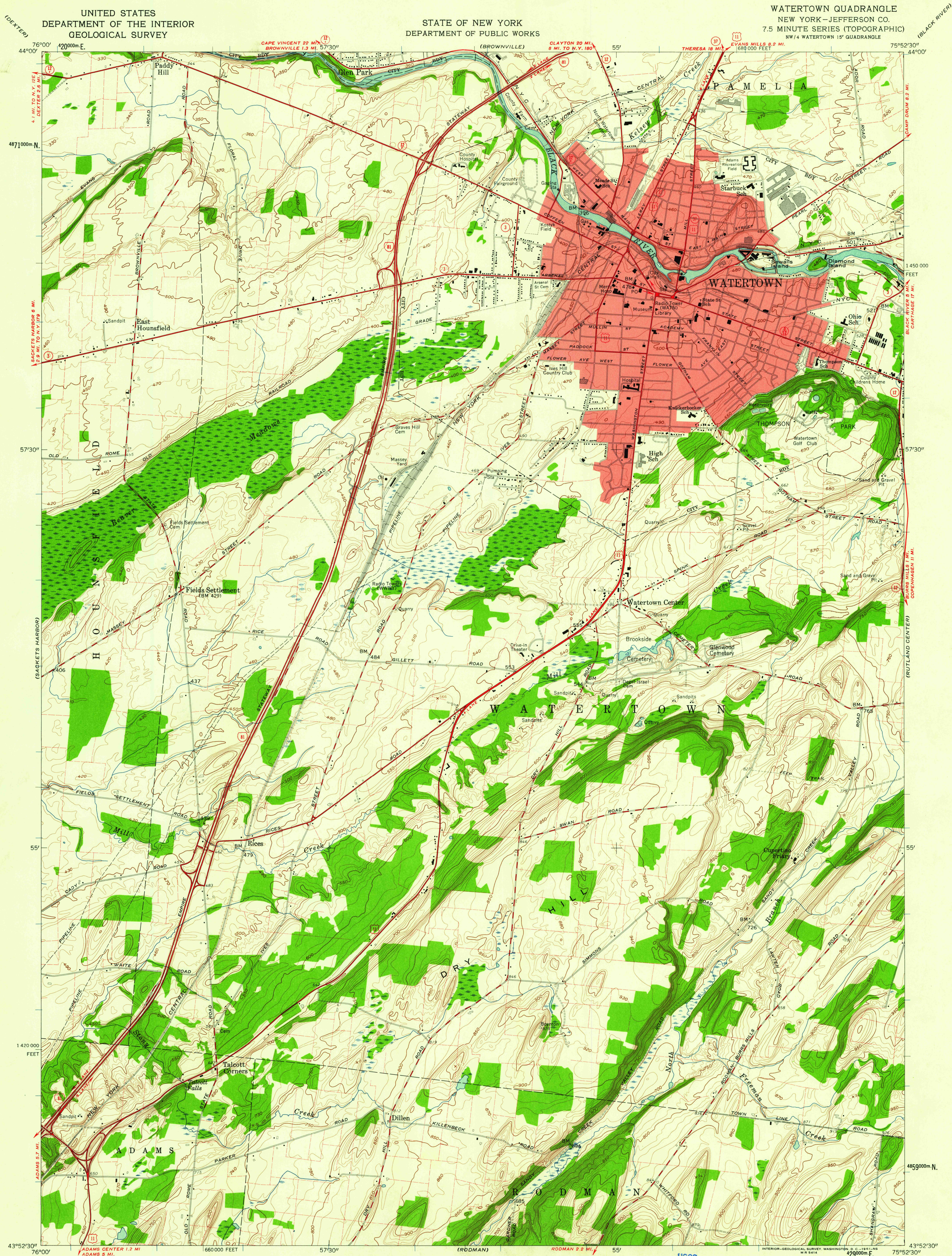

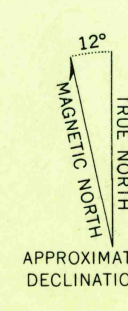
10,000-foot grid based on New York coordinate system, central zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue

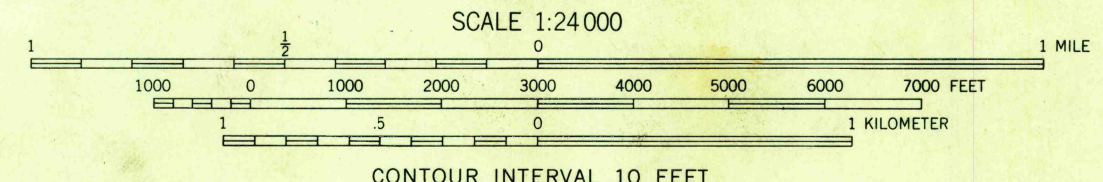
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
