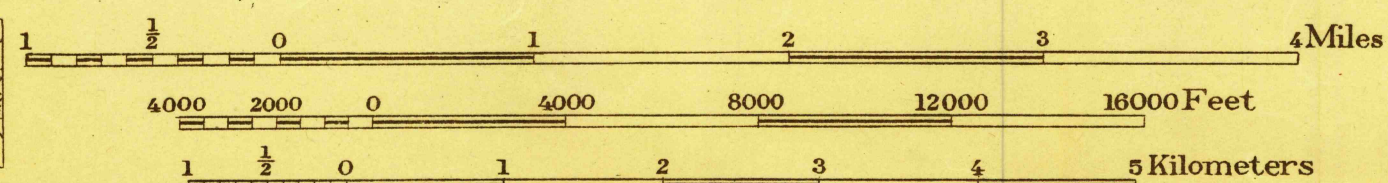

CHILDWOLD QUADRANGLE



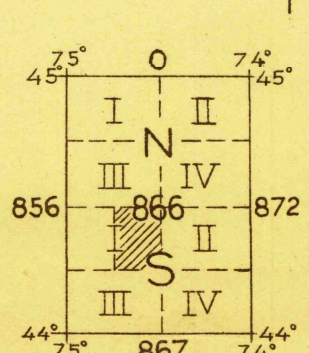
