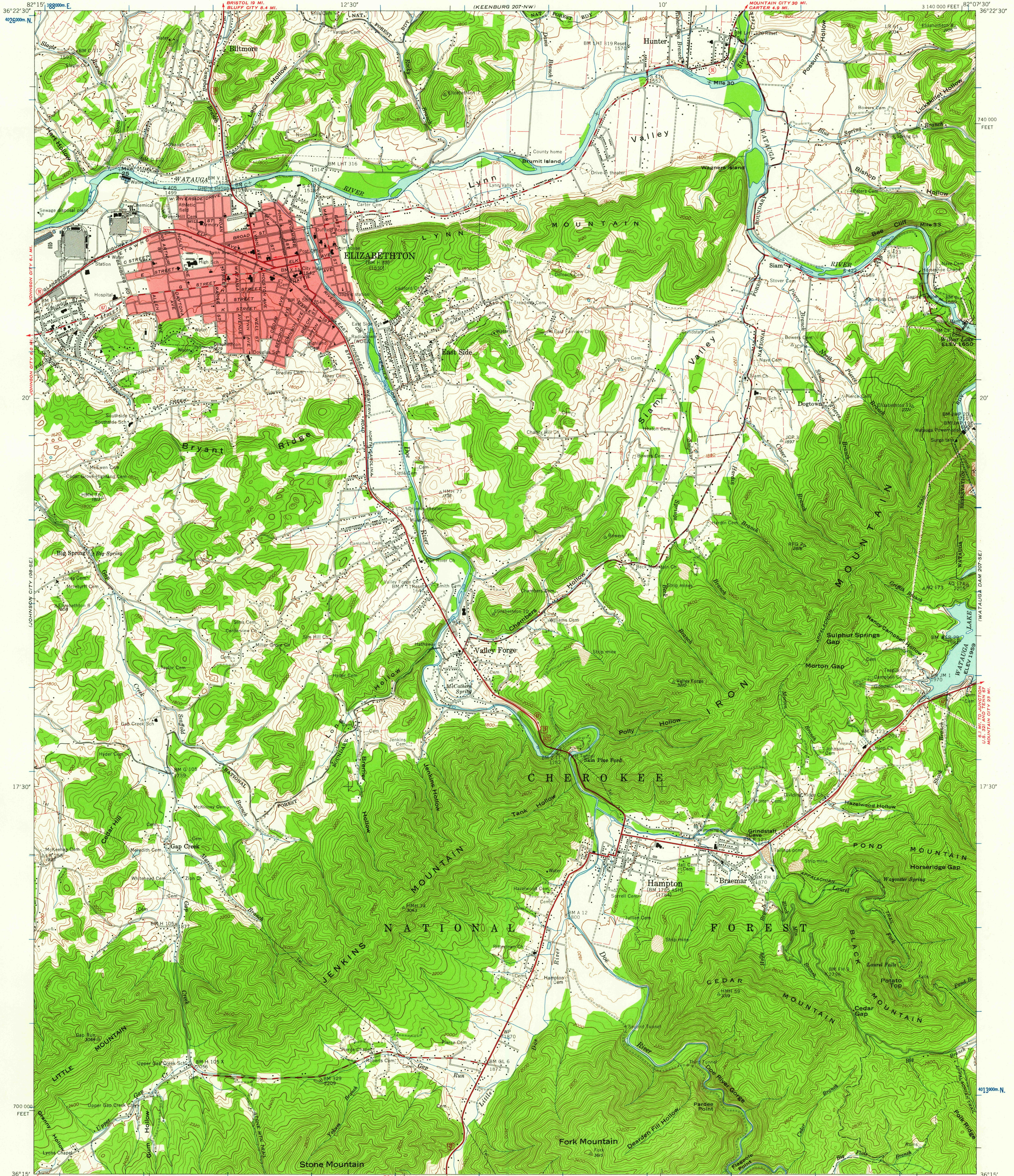

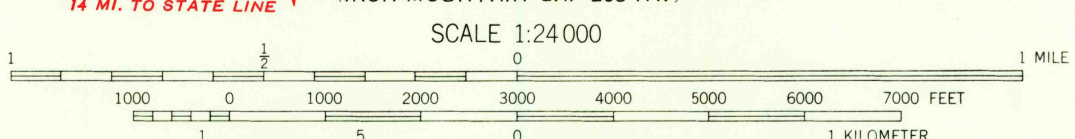

DECLINATION 1960



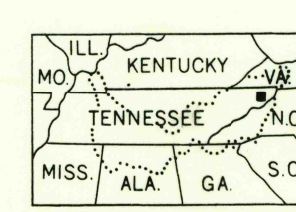
